

CHARGES

Police Officer JoAnne Hazard, Star Number 9738, is charged with violating the following rules contained in Article V of the Rules and Regulations of the Chicago Police Department ("Department") which were in full force and effect on the date of the alleged violations:

- Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.
- Rule 5: Failure to perform any duty.
- Rule 11: Incompetency or inefficiency in the performance of duty.
- Rule 14: Making a false report, written or oral.

SPECIFICATIONS

1. Police Officer JoAnne Hazard, Star Number 9738, is charged with violating Rule 2 in that on June 11, 1997, at 3537 N. Sheffield Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, she failed to come to the assistance of fellow officers struggling with an arrestee, although she was present and capable of doing so, thereby impeding the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals and/or bringing discredit upon the Department.

2. Police Officer JoAnne Hazard, Star Number 9738, is charged with violating Rule 5 in that on June 11, 1997, at 3537 N. Sheffield Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, she failed to come to the assistance of fellow officers struggling with an arrestee, although she was present and capable of doing so.

3. Police Officer JoAnne Hazard, Star Number 9738, is charged with violating Rule 11 in that on June 11, 1997, at 3537 N. Sheffield Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, she failed to come to the assistance of fellow officers struggling with an

arrestee, although she was present and capable of doing so.


4. Police Officer JoAnne Hazard, Star Number 9738, is charged with violating Rule 14 in that on August 21, 1997, and November 4, 1999, she falsely stated that she had volunteered to assist other police officers who had responded to a report of a suspicious person at 3537 N. Sheffield Avenue, Chicago, Illinois.

Based on the above-stated charges, the Superintendent recommends that Police Officer JoAnne Hazard, Star Number 9738, be discharged from the Chicago Police Department.
