FINDINGS AND DECISION

On August 18, 2000, the Superintendent of Police filed charges with the Police Board of the City of Chicago, seeking the separation of Police Officer MICHAEL LEVERETT, Star #19713, hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Respondent" for violation of the following rules:

- RULE 2 "Any action or conduct which
 impedes the Department's efforts to achieve
 its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the
 Department."
- RULE 6 "Disobedience of any order or directive, whether written or oral."
- RULE 9 "Engaging in any unjustified
 verbal or physical altercation with any
 person, while on or off duty."
- RULE 15 "Intoxication on or off duty."
- RULE 38 "Unlawful or unnecessary display of a weapon."
- RULE 39 "Failure to immediately make an oral report to the desk sergeant at the District of occurrence and to follow such oral report with a written report

on the prescribed form, whenever a firearm is discharged by a member.

The Police Board of the City of Chicago, caused a hearing on these charges against Police Officer MICHAEL LEVERETT, Star #19713, to be heard by JACQUELINE A. WALKER, Hearing Officer of the Police Board of the City of Chicago on January 10, 2001, and a Hearing in Aggravation and Mitigation on July 2, 2001. Following the Hearing, the members of the Police Board read and reviewed the certified transcription of the proceedings of the hearing.

JACQUELINE A. WALKER, Hearing Officer made an oral report and conferred with the Police Board before it rendered a decision.

As a result of the foregoing, the Police Board of the City of Chicago finds and determines that:

- (1) The Respondent was, at all times mentioned herein, a Police Officer employed by the Department of Police of the City of Chicago;
- (2) The charges were filed, in writing, and a Notice, stating the time, date and place, when and where a hearing on the charges was to be held, together with a copy of the original charges were served upon the Respondent more than five (5) days prior to the hearing on the charges;
- (3) Throughout the hearing, the Respondent appeared in person and was represented by legal counsel;

- (4) The Respondent, Police Officer MICHAEL LEVERETT,

 Star #19713, as charged herein, is guilty of

 violating, to-wit:
- RULE 2 "Any action or conduct which impedes

 the Department's efforts to achieve

 its policy and goals or brings

 discredit upon the Department", in the

 following instances:
- (A) On or about February 25, 2000, at approximately 1330 hours, at or about 3812 North Albany, second floor, while off duty, he discharged his weapon while intoxicated.
- (B) On or about February 25, 2000, at approximately 1330 hours, at or about 3812 North Albany, second floor, while off duty, he failed to make the required notifications regarding discharge of his weapon.
- (C) On or about February 25, 2000, at approximately 1330 hours, at or about 3812 North Albany, second floor, while off duty, he engaged in an unjustified altercation with the victim, Diana Poggy.
- (D) On or about February 25, 2000, at approximately 1330 hours, at or about 3812 North Albany, second floor, while off duty, he threatened to commit suicide.
- (E) On or about February 25, 2000, at approximately 1330 hours, at or about 3812 North Albany, second floor,

while off duty, he possessed his firearm while consuming alcoholic beverages.

- (F) On or about February 25, 2000, at approximately 1330 hours, at or about 3812 North Albany, second floor, while off duty, he possessed one or more unregistered firearms.
- (G) On or about February 25, 2000, at approximately 1330 hours, at or about 3812 North Albany, second floor, while off duty, he placed his gun into his mouth and/or relinquished his firearm to victim Diana Poggy and/or told her to shoot him.
- 5) Respondent, Police Officer MICHAEL LEVERETT, Star #19713, as charged herein, is guilty of violating, to-wit:
 - RULE 6 "Disobedience of any order or
 directive, whether written or oral," in
 the following instances:
- (A) On or about February 25, 2000, at approximately 1330 hours, at or about 3812 North Albany, second floor, while off duty, he disobeyed the provisions of General Order 86-8, III, A, in that he discharged his firearm one or more times when the use of such force was not necessary.
- (B) On or about February 25, 2000, at approximately 1330 hours, at or about 3812 North Albany, second floor, while off duty, he disobeyed the provisions of

General Order 99-01, Section V, A (a) (d), in that he failed to immediately notify the Office of Emergency

Communications, or the District of the occurrence.

- (C) On or about February 25, 2000, at approximately 1330 hours, at or about 3812 North Albany, second floor, while off duty, he disobeyed the provisions of General Order 00-01, Section V, A (f), in that he failed to complete a Weapons Discharge Report or To-From Subject Report, after discharging his weapon at said location.
- (D) On or about February 25, 2000, at approximately 1330 hours, at or about 3812 North Albany, second floor, while off duty, he disobeyed the provisions of General Order 92-3 Addendum 5B, Section IV, B, in that he was found to possess one or more unregistered firearms.
- (E) On or about February 25, 2000, prior to 1245
 1250 hours, at or about "My Mistake" bar located at or about
 23rd and Damen, while off duty, he disobeyed provisions of
 General Order 92-3, Section III, C, in that he consumed
 alcoholic beverages while in possession of his firearm.
- (6) The Respondent, Police Officer MICHAEL LEVERETT,
 Star #19713, as charged herein, is guilty of violating, towit:
 - RULE 9 "Engaging in any unjustified verbal or
 physical altercation with any person,
 while on or off duty," in that:

On or about February 25, 2000, at approximately 1330 hours, at or about 3812 N. Albany, second floor, while off duty, he pulled Diana Poggy from her bed and/or grabbed her by the arms, and/or pushed her.

- (7) The Respondent, Police Officer MICHAEL LEVERETT, Star #19713, as charged herein, is guilty of violating, to-wit:
 - RULE 15 "Intoxication on or off duty," in
 that:

On or about February 25, 2000, at approximately 1330 hours, at or about 3812 North Albany, second floor, while off duty, he was intoxicated.

- (8) The Respondent, Police Officer MICHAEL LEVERETT, Star #19713, as charged herein, is guilty of violating, to-wit:

On or about February 25, 2000, at approximately 1330 hours, at or about 3812 North Albany, second floor, while off duty, he unnecessarily discharged his weapon one or more times.

- (9) The Respondent, Police Officer MICHAEL

 LEVERETT, Star #19713, as charged herein, is guilty of violating, to-wit:
 - RULE 39 "Failure to immediately make an oral report to the desk

> sergeant at the District of occurrence and to follow such oral report with a written report on the prescribed form, whenever a firearm is discharged by a member," in

that:

On or about February 25, 2000, at approximately 1330 hours, at or about 3812 North Albany, second floor, while off duty, he failed to make an oral report to the desk sergeant at the District of the occurrence and failed to follow such oral report with a written report on the prescribed form, after discharging his weapon.

Following the Police Board's finding of quilty as indicated herein, the Police Board ordered a Hearing in Aggravation and Mitigation to be conducted. Such a hearing was duly conducted before JACQUELINE A. WALKER, Hearing Officer.

BY REASON of the findings of fact and of quilty herein, cause exists for the suspension of Respondent, Police Officer MICHAEL LEVERETT, Star #19713 from the Department of Police and from the services of the City of Chicago.

DECISION

The members of the Police Board, having read and reviewed the certified copy of the transcription of the hearing, having received the oral report of the Hearing Officer, JACQUELINE A. WALKER, and having conferred with the Hearing Officer on the credibility of the witnesses and the evidence, hereby adopt all findings herein and, in reaching its decision as to the penalty imposed, the Board has taken into account not only the facts of this case but also the respondent's complimentary and disciplinary history, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A; and;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the respondent, Police Officer MICHAEL LEVERETT, Star # 19713, as a result of having been found guilty of the charges in Police Board Case 00-2426, is hereby suspended from his position as a Police Officer, and from the services of the City of Chicago, from August 19, 2000, to and including July 31, 2001.
