

CHARGES

Crossing Guard Edwina Banks, Employee Number 508350, is charged with violating the following rules contained in Article V of the Rules and Regulations of the Chicago Police Department ("Department") which were in full force and effect on the date of the alleged violations:

- Rule 1: Violation of any law or ordinance.
- Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.
- Rule 6: Disobedience of an order or directive, whether oral or written.

SPECIFICATIONS


1. Crossing Guard Edwina Banks, Employee Number 508350, is charged with violating Rule 1 in that on or about May 28, 2000, she rendered a urine specimen which contained cocaine metabolites, thus evidencing possession, ingestion, or other use of a controlled substance, i.e. cocaine, in violation of 720 ILCS 570/402.
2. Crossing Guard Edwina Banks, Employee Number 508350, is charged with violating Rule 2 in that on or about May 28, 2000, she rendered a urine specimen which contained cocaine metabolites, thus evidencing possession, ingestion, or other use of a controlled substance, i.e. cocaine, and thereby impeded the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals and/or brought discredit upon the Department.
3. Crossing Guard Edwina Banks, Employee Number 508350, is charged with violating Rule 6 in that on or about May 28, 2000, she rendered a urine specimen which contained cocaine metabolites, thus evidencing possession, ingestion, or other

use of a controlled substance, i.e. cocaine, in violation of General Order 90-5, Article III(B).

Based on the above-stated charges, the Superintendent recommends that Crossing Guard Edwina Banks, Employee Number 508350, be discharged from the Chicago Police Department.
