

CHARGES

Gang Crimes Specialist John F. Galligan, Star Number 60043, is charged with violating the following rules contained in Article V of the Rules and Regulations of the Chicago Police Department, which were in full force and effect on the date(s) of the alleged violations:

- Rule 1: Violation of any law or ordinance.
- Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.
- Rule 4: Any conduct or action taken to use the official position for personal gain or influence.

SPECIFICATIONS

Gang Crimes Specialist (GCS) John F. Galligan, Star Number 60043, is charged with violating Rule 1, "Violation of any law or ordinance," in one or more of the following instances:

- Count I: Beginning in or about 1994, and continuing until in or about 1998, or for some period of time therein, GCS Galligan did conspire with others to knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute and to distribute 5 kilograms or more of mixtures containing cocaine and 50 grams or more of mixtures containing cocaine base, both Schedule II Narcotic Drug Controlled Substances, and quantity of mixtures containing heroin, a Schedule I Narcotic Drug Controlled Substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1); Title 21, United States Code, Section 846; and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.
- Count II: In and about September 1995, GCS Galligan knowingly did conspire with others to commit extortion affecting commerce by wrongful use of actual and threatened force and fear, and under color of official right, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 1951 and 2.

- Count III: On or about September 26, 1995, GCS Galligan knowingly and intentionally obtained property, namely cocaine, from a person residing at 5306 West Altgeld in Chicago, through extortion affecting commerce by wrongful use of actual and threatened force and fear, and under color of official right, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951 and 2.
- Count IV: On or about September 26, 1995, GCS Galligan did knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute 500 grams or more of mixtures containing cocaine, a Schedule II narcotic drug controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.
- Count V: On or about September 26, 1995, GCS Galligan, used and carried a firearm during and in relation to crimes of violence, namely, conspiracy to commit extortion and extortion affecting commerce involving wrongful use of actual and threatened force and fear, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951 and a drug trafficking crime, namely, possession with intent to distribute cocaine, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1), thereby violating Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(c).

Gang Crimes Specialist (GCS) John F. Galligan, Star Number 60043, is charged with violating Rule 2, "Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department," in one or more of the following instances:

- Count I: Beginning in or about 1994, and continuing until in or about 1998, or for some period of time therein, GCS Galligan did conspire with others to knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute and to distribute 5 kilograms or more of mixtures containing cocaine and 50 grams or more of mixtures containing cocaine base, both Schedule II Narcotic Drug Controlled Substances, and quantity of mixtures containing heroin, a Schedule I Narcotic Drug Controlled Substance.
- Count II: In and about September 1995, GCS Galligan knowingly did conspire with others to commit extortion affecting commerce by wrongful use of actual and threatened force and fear, and under color of official right.

- Count III: On or about September 26, 1995, GCS Galligan knowingly and intentionally obtained property, namely cocaine, from a person residing at 5306 West Altgeld in Chicago, through extortion affecting commerce by wrongful use of actual and threatened force and fear, and under color of official right.
- Count IV: On or about September 26, 1995, GCS Galligan did knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute 500 grams or more of mixtures containing cocaine, a Schedule II narcotic drug controlled substance.
- Count V: On or about September 26, 1995, GCS Galligan, used and carried a firearm during and in relation to crimes of violence, namely, conspiracy to commit extortion and extortion affecting commerce involving wrongful use of actual and threatened force and fear.
- Count VI: From on or about 1995 until 1998, or for some period of time therein, GCS Galligan used his official position as a Chicago Police Officer to conspire with others to possess with the intent to distribute and to distribute kilogram quantities of cocaine, a Schedule II Controlled Substance, and quantities of heroin, a Schedule I Controlled Substance and to protect the distribution of narcotics by interfering with legitimate law enforcement units, thereby using his official position for personal gain and influence.

Gang Crimes Specialist (GCS) John F. Galligan, Star Number 60043, is charged with violating Rule 4, "Any conduct or action taken to use the official position for personal gain or influence," in the following instance:

From on or about 1995 until 1998, or for some period of time therein, GCS Galligan used his official position as a Chicago Police Officer to conspire with others to possess with the intent to distribute and to distribute kilogram quantities of cocaine, a Schedule II Controlled Substance, and quantities of heroin, a Schedule I Controlled Substance and to protect the distribution of narcotics by interfering with legitimate law enforcement units, thereby using his official position for personal gain and influence.

Based on the foregoing charges and specifications, the Superintendent of Police recommends that Gang Crimes Specialist John F. Galligan, Star Number 60043, be discharged from the Chicago Police Department.
