FINDINGS AND DECISION

On January 9, 2001, the Superintendent of Police filed charges with the Police

Board of the City of Chicago, seeking the separation of Fingerprint Technician

CHARLENE BONONES, Employee #060785, hereinafter sometimes referred to as

"Respondent" for violation of the following rules:

<u>RULE 1</u> - "Violation of any law or ordinance."

RULE 2 - "Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department."

RULE 8 - "Disrespect to or maltreatment of any person, while on or off duty."

RULE 9 - "Engaging in an unjustified verbal or physical altercation with any person, while on or off duty."

The Police Board of the City of Chicago caused a hearing on theses charges against Fingerprint Technician, CHARLENE BONONES, Employee #060785 to be heard by JACQUELINE A. WALKER, Hearing Officer of the Police Board of the City of Chicago, on April 17, 2001. Following the Hearing, the members of the Police Board read and reviewed the certified transcription of the proceedings of the hearing.

JACQUELINE A. WALKER, Hearing Officer made an oral report and conferred with the Police Board before it rendered a decision.

As a result of the foregoing, the Police Board of the City of Chicago finds and determines that:

- (1) The Respondent was, at all times mentioned herein, a Fingerprint Technician employed by the Department of Police of the City of Chicago;
- (2) The charges were filed, in writing, and a Notice, stating the time, date and place, when and where a hearing in the charges was to be held, together with a copy of the original charges were served upon the Respondent more than five (5) days prior to the hearing on the charges;
- (3) Throughout the hearing, the Respondent did not appear in person and was not represented by legal counsel;
- (4) The Respondent, Fingerprint Technician **CHARLENE BONONES**, Employee #060785, as charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to-wit:
- <u>RULE 1</u> "Violation of any law or ordinance", in the following instances:
- A. On or about July 9, 1999, at or near 2900 West 69th Street, while off duty, she was involved in a property damage accident and left the scene without exchanging any information with the other party involved in the accident, in violation of Chapter 625 ILCS 5/11-402 and/or 11-403.
- B. On or about July 9, 1999, at or near 3000 West 69th Street, while off duty, she committed the offense of Aggravated Battery, in that after Police Officer Yvonne Danzy identified herself as a Police Officer, she struck Police Officer Danzy

with her vehicle while fleeing the scene of an accident, in violation of Chapter 720 ILCS 5/12-4.

- C. On or about July 9, 1999, at or near 79th Street and Kilpatrick Avenue, while off duty, she committed the offense of Fleeing and/or Eluding, in that she failed to stop for a marked police vehicle whose emergency equipment was activated, and/or attempted to drive over a curb, when Police Officer Mark Metelski signaled from the vehicle, in violation of Chapter 625 ILCS 5/11-204.
- D. On or about July 9, 1999, at or near 79th Street and Kilpatrick Avenue, while off duty, she committed the offense of Aggravated Battery, in that she bit Police Officer Mark Metelski one or more times, while he was attempting to arrest her, in violation of Chapter 720 ILCS 5/12-4.
- E. On or about July 9, 1999, at or near 83rd Street and Central Avenue, while off duty, she committed the offense of Aggravated Battery, in that she struck Police Officer Kenneth Dangman with her vehicle, while he was attempting to arrest her, in violation of Chapter 720 ILCS 5/12-4.
- (5) The Respondent, Fingerprint Technician **CHARLENE BONONES**, Employee #060785 as charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to-wit:
 - <u>RULE 2</u> "Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon theDepartment", in the following instances:
 - A. On or about July 9, 1999, at or near 2900 West 69th Street, while off

duty, she was involved in a property damage accident and left the scene without exchanging any information with the other party involved in the accident, in violation of Chapter 625 ILCS 5/11-402 and/or 11-403.

- B. On or about July 9, 1999, at or near 3000 West 69th Street, while off duty, she committed the offense of Aggravated Battery, in that after Police Officer Yvonne Danzy identified herself as a Police Officer, she struck Police Officer Danzy with her vehicle while fleeing the scene of an accident, in violation of Chapter 720 ILCS 5/12-4.
- C. On or about July 9, 1999, at or near 79th Street and Kilpatrick Avenue, while off duty, she committed the offense of Fleeing and/or Eluding, in that she failed to stop for a marked police vehicle whose emergency equipment was activated, and/or attempted to drive over a curb, when Police Officer Mark Metelski signaled from the vehicle, in violation of Chapter 625 ILCS 5/11-204.
- D. On or about July 9, 1999, at or near 79th Street and Kilpatrick Avenue, while off duty, she committed the offense of Aggravated Battery, in that she bit Police Officer Mark Metelski one or more times, while he was attempting to arrest her, in violation of Chapter 720 ILCS 5/12-4.
- E. On or about July 9, 1999, at or near 83rd Street and Central Avenue, while off duty, she committed the offense of Aggravated Battery, in that she struck Police Officer Kenneth Dangman with her vehicle, while he was attempting to arrest her, in violation of Chapter 720 ILCS 5/12-4.

- (6) The Respondent, Fingerprint Technician **CHARLENE BONONES**, Employee # 060785 as charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to-wit:
 - **RULE 8** -"Disrespect to or maltreatment of any person, while on or off duty", in the following instances:
- A. On or about July 9, 1999, at or near 3000 West 69th Street, while off duty, she mistreated and/or disrespected Police Officer Yvonne Danzy in that she struck Police Officer Danzy with her vehicle.
- B. On or about July 9, 1999, at or neat 79th Street and Kilpatrick Avenue, while off duty, she mistreated and/or disrespected Police Officer Mark Metelski, in that she failed to stop for a marked police vehicle whose emergency equipment was activated, and/or attempted to drive over a curb, when Police Officer Mark Metelski signaled from the vehicle.
- C. On or about July 9, 1999, at or neat 79th Street and Kilpatrick Avenue, while off duty, she mistreated and/or disrespected Police Officer Mark Metelski when she bit Police Officer Mark Metelski one or more times.
- D. On or about July 9, 1999, at or near 83rd Street and Central Avenue, while off duty, she mistreated and/or disrespected Police Officer Kenneth Dangman, in that she struck Police Officer Kenneth Dangman with her vehicle.
- (7) The Respondent, Fingerprint Technician **CHARLENE BONONES**, Employee #060785 as charged herein is **guilty** of violating, to-wit:
 - **RULE 9** "Engaging in an unjustified verbal or physical altercation with any person, while on or off duty",

in the following instances:

- A. On or about July 9, 1999, at or near 3000 West 69th Street, while off duty, she engaged in an unjustified verbal and/or physical altercation with Police Officer Yvonne Danzy, in that she struck Police Officer Danzy with her vehicle.
- B. On or about July 9, 1999, at or near 79th Street and Kilpatrick Avenue, while off duty, she engaged in an unjustified verbal and/or physical altercation with Police Officer Mark Metelski, in that she failed to stop for a marked police vehicle whose emergency equipment was activated, and/or attempted to drive over a curb, when Police Officer Mark Metelski signaled from the vehicle.
- C. On or about July 9, 1999, at or near 79th Street and Kilpatrick Avenue, while off duty, she engaged in an unjustified verbal and/or physical altercation with Police Officer Mark Metelski, in that she bit Police Officer Mark Metelski one or more times.
- D. On or about July 9, 1999, at or near 83rd Street and Central Avenue, while off duty, she engaged in an unjustified verbal and/or physical altercation with Police Officer Kenneth Dangman, in that she struck Police Officer Kenneth Dangman with her vehicle.

BY REASON of the findings of fact and of guilty herein, cause exists for the separation and discharge of Respondent, Fingerprint Technician CHARLENE

BONONES, Employee #060785 from the Department of Police and from the services of

the City of Chicago.

DECISION

The members of the Police Board, having read and reviewed the certified copy of the transcription of the hearing, having received the oral report of the Hearing Officer, JACQUELINE A. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the respondent, Fingerprint Technician **CHARLENE BONONES**, Employee # 060785, as a result of having been found guilty of the charges in Police Board Case 01-2444, is hereby separated and discharged from her position as a Fingerprint Technician, and from the services of the City of Chicago.


