FINDINGS & DECISION

On February 22, 2001, the Superintendent of Police filed charges with the Police Board of the City of Chicago against Police Officer Lawrence Thompson, Star # 4602, (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Respondent") seeking the discharge of Respondent for violating the following Rules:

- Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.
- Rule 8: Disrespect to or maltreatment of any person, while on or off duty.
- Rule 9: Engaging in any unjustified verbal or physical altercation with any person, while on or off duty.

The Police Board of the City of Chicago caused a hearing on these charges against Police officer Lawrence Thompson to be had before Michael G. Berland, Hearing Officer of the Police Board of the City of Chicago on September 25, 2001, September 26, 2001, October 23, 2001 and December 18, 2001.

Following the hearing, the members of the Police Board read and reviewed the certified transcription of the proceedings of the hearing. Michael G. Berland, Hearing Officer, made an oral report and conferred with the Police Board before it rendered a decision.

The Police Board of the City of Chicago, as a result of its investigation of the charges, finds and determines that:

- 1. The Respondent was at all times a Police Officer employed by the Department of Police of the City of Chicago.
- 2. The charges were filed in writing and a Notice, stating the time, date and place, when and where a hearing of the charges was to be held, together with a copy of the original charges, was served upon the Respondent more than five (5) days prior to the hearing on the charges.
- 3. The hearing was conducted before Michael G. Berland, Hearing Officer of the Police Board of the City of Chicago, on September 25, 2001, September 26, 2001, October 23, 2001 and December 18, 2001.
- 4. Throughout the hearing the Respondent did appear in person and was represented by counsel of his choice.
- 5. Respondent Police Officer Lawrence Thompson, Star #4062, charged herein, contrary to the Rules and Regulations, is guilty of violating, to wit:
- Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.
- A. On or about July 21, 2000, at approximately 1936 hours, while in the vicinity of 7501 S. Cottage Grove, Police Officer Lawrence Thompson, while on duty, without justification, struck Anthony Brown about the body with a baton and/or his own body.
- 6. Respondent Police Officer Lawrence Thompson, Star#4062, charged herein, contrary to the Rules and Regulations, is <u>quilty</u>

of violating, to wit:

<u>Rule 8</u>: Disrespect to or maltreatment of any person, while on or off duty.

A. On or about July 21, 2000, at approximately 1936 hours, while in the vicinity of 7501 S. Cottage Grove, Police Officer Lawrence Thompson, while on duty, without justification, struck Anthony Brown about the body with a baton and/or his own body.

7. Respondent Police Officer Lawrence Thompson, Star #4062, charged herein, contrary to the Rules and Regulations, is guilty of violating, to wit:

A. On or about July 21, 2000, at approximately 1936 hours, while in the vicinity of 7501 S. Cottage Grove, Police Officer Lawrence Thompson, while on duty, without justification, struck Anthony Brown about the body with a baton and/or his own body.

By reason of the findings of fact that the Respondent Police Officer Lawrence Thompson, Star#4602, is guilty of violating of Rules 2, 8, and 9, Lawrence Thompson is hereby suspended from his position as a Police Officer with the Department of Police and from the services of the City of Chicago from February 24, 2001 to and including August 23, 2002 with restoration of rights and benefits thereafter.
