CHARGES

Police Officer Kenneth B. Hill, Star Number 9159, is charged with violating the following rules contained in Article V of the Rules and Regulations of the Chicago Police Department, which were in full force and effect on the dates of the alleged violations:

Rule 1: Violation of any law or ordinance;

Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its

policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department;

Rule 6: Disobedience of an order or directive, whether written or oral.

SPECIFICATIONS

1. Police Officer Kenneth B. Hill, Star Number 9159, is charged with violating Rule 1, "Violation of any law or ordinance," in the following instance:

On or about November 3, 2000, Officer Hill rendered a urine specimen which contained cocaine metabolites, and thus, on or before November 3, 2000, possessed cocaine, in violation of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, Chapter 720 ILCS, Section 570/402(c).

2. Police Officer Kenneth B. Hill, Star Number 9159, is charged with violating Rule 2, "Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department," in the following instance:

On or about November 3, 2000, Officer Hill rendered a urine specimen which contained cocaine metabolites, thereby impeding the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals and/or bringing discredit upon the Department.

3. Police Officer Kenneth B. Hill, Star Number 9159, is charged with violating Rule 6, "Disobedience of an order or directive, whether written or oral," in the following instance:

On or about November 3, 2000, Officer Hill rendered a urine specimen which contained cocaine metabolites, thereby violating General Order 90-5, Article III, Section B.

Based on the foregoing charges and specifications, the Superintendent recommends that Police Officer Kenneth B. Hill, Star Number 9159, be discharged from the Chicago Police Department.
