### FINDINGS AND DECISION

On April 16, 2001, the Superintendent of Police filed charges with the Police Board of the City of Chicago, seeking the separation of Police Officer DARRELL WESSON, Star #6846, hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Respondent" for violation of the following rules:

- RULE 2 " Any action or conduct which
  impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its
  policy and goals or brings discredit upon the
  Department."
- RULE 6 " Disobedience of an order or
  directive, whether written or oral."
- RULE 8 " Disrespect to or maltreatment of
  any person, while on or off duty."
- RULE 9 " Engaging in any unjustified
  verbal or physical altercation
  with any person, while on or off duty."

The Police Board of the City of Chicago caused a hearing on these charges against Police Officer DARRELL WESSON, Star #6846, to be heard by JACQUELINE A. WALKER, Hearing Officer of the Police Board of the City of Chicago, on September 19, 2001 and October 25, 2001. Following the

Hearing, the members of the Police Board read and review

Hearing, the members of the Police Board read and reviewed the certified transcription of the proceedings of the hearing. JACQUELINE A. WALKER, Hearing Officer made an oral report and conferred with the Police Board before it rendered a decision.

As a result of the foregoing, the Police Board of the City of Chicago finds and determines that:

- (1) The Respondent was, at all times mentioned herein, a Police Officer employed by the Department of Police of the City of Chicago;
- (2) The charges were filed, in writing, and a Notice, stating the time, date and place, when and where a hearing on the charges was to be held, together with a copy of the original charges were served upon the Respondent more than five (5) days prior to the hearing on the charges;
- (3) Throughout the hearing, the Respondent appeared in person and was represented by legal counsel;
- (4) The Respondent, Police Officer DARRELL WESSON, Star #6846, as charged herein, is guilty of violating, to-wit:
- RULE 2 "Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department", in the following instances:
  - (A) On or about April 10, 2000, at or near 7751 S.

    Christiana Avenue, while off duty, he grabbed Lori

    Wesson by the arms and/or pushed her against a wall

with a flashlight.

and/or slapped her on the face and/or kicked her on the leg and/or struck her about the head and/or body with his hand and/or struck her about the head and/or body

- (B) On or about April 10, 2000, at or near 7751 S. Christiana Avenue, while off duty, he pulled out his gun and/or placed his gun to the body of Lori Wesson and/or threatened to kill Lori Wesson.
- (C) On or about April 10, 2000, he became aware that he was named as a respondent in an order of protection and failed to immediately submit a to/from/subject report regarding the order, in violation of General Order 93-3, Addendum 5, II, K, 1, a.
- (5) Respondent, **DARRELL WESSON**, Star #6846, as charged herein, is **quilty** of violating, to-wit:
- RULE 6 " Disobedience of an order or
  directive, whether written or oral", in that:

On or about April 10, 2000, he became aware that he was named as a respondent in an order of protection and failed to immediately submit a to/from/subject report regarding the order, in violation of General Order 93-3, Addendum 5, II, K, 1 a.

- (6) Respondent, **DARRELL WESSON**, Star #6846, as charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to-wit:
  - RULE 8 "Disrespect to or maltreatment of any
    person, while on or off duty, in the following
    instances:

- (A) On or about April 10, 2000, at or near 7751 S. Christiana Avenue, while off duty, he grabbed Lori Wesson and/or pushed her against a wall.
- (B) On or about April 10, 2000, at or near 7751 S. Christiana Avenue, while off duty, he slapped Lori Wesson and/or kicked her.
- (C) On or about April 10, 2000, at or near 7751 S. Christiana Avenue, while off duty, he struck Lori Wesson about the body with his hands and/or with a flashlight.
- (D) On or about April 10, 2000, at or near 7751 S. Christiana Avenue, while off duty, he pulled out his gun and/or placed his gun to the body of Lori Wesson and/or threatened to kill Lori Weston.
- (7) The Respondent, **DARRELL WESSON**, Star #6846, as charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to-wit:
  - RULE 9 " Engaging in any unjustified
     verbal or physical altercation
     with any person, while on or off duty,"
     in the following instances:
  - (A) On or about April 10, 2000, at or near 7751 S. Christiana Avenue, while off duty, he grabbed Lori Wesson and/or pushed her against a wall.
  - (B) On or about April 10, 2000, at or near 7751 S. Christiana Avenue, while off duty, he slapped Lori Wesson and/or kicked her.
  - (C) On or about April 10, 2000, at or near 7751 S. Christiana Avenue, while off duty, he struck Lori Wesson about the body with his hands and/or with a flashlight.

- (D) On or about April 10, 2000, at or near 7751 S. Christiana Avenue, while off duty, he pulled out his gun and/or placed his gun to the body of Lori Wesson and/or threatened to kill Lori Wesson.
- (8) The Respondent, **DARRELL WESSON**, Star #6846, as charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to-wit:

RULE 38 - " Unlawful or unnecessary use or display of a weapon", in that:

On or about April 10, 2000, at or near 7751 S. Christiana Avenue, while off duty, he pulled out his gun and/or placed his gun to the body of Lori Wesson and/or threatened to kill Lori Wesson.

BY REASON of the findings of fact and of guilty herein, cause exists for the suspension of Respondent, Police Officer DARRELL WESSON, Star #6846, from the Department of Police and from the services of the City of Chicago.

### DECISION

The members of the Police Board, having read and reviewed the certified copy of the transcription of the hearing, having received the oral report of the Hearing Officer, Jacqueline Walker, hereby adopts all findings, and;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Respondent, Police Officer Darrell Wesson, Star # 6846, as a result of being found quilty of violations of Rules 2, 6, 8, 9, and 38, is hereby suspended from his position as a Police Officer from the Department of Police and from the services of the City of Chicago from April 18, 2001, until he successfully completes an approved domestic violence counseling program, and until the Board issues a further Order reinstating The domestic violence program that Officer Wesson enrolls in must be approved by the Department's Personnel Concerns Program before he enrolls in it, and must be completed under the supervision of the Personnel Concerns Program. The counseling agency shall indicate in writing on its official letterhead stationary whether Officer Wesson successfully completed the program or if he failed to successfully complete the program. Officer Wesson shall sign the necessary waivers of confidentiality to permit the counseling program to make its report. The domestic counseling program shall be undertaken by Officer Wesson on his own time and at his own expense. Notwithstanding the foregoing, if Officer Wesson is enrolled in a City health insurance plan which would pay for such a counseling program, he shall be entitled to

seek reimbursement from such plan, subject to the plan's normal requirements. Officer Wesson shall remain suspended until further Order of the Board is issued. Officer Wesson shall tender the documents showing successful completion of an approved domestic violence counseling program on or before October 31, 2002 The Board shall reconsider this matter after receiving documents from Officer Wesson showing successful completion of an approved domestic violence counseling program. In the event Officer Wesson fails to submit such documentation on or before October 31, 2002, the Board shall issue such further Order as it deems appropriate.
