FINDINGS AND DECISION

On January 4, 2002, the Superintendent of Police filed charges with the Police

Board of the City of Chicago, seeking the separation of Civilian Senior Data Entry

Operator SOMOCKI S. BRANNON, Employee # 518601, hereinafter sometimes

referred to as "Respondent" for violation of the following rules:

<u>RULE 1</u> :	"Violation of any law or ordinance."
<u>RULE 2</u> :	"Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's
	efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit
	upon the Department."
<u>RULE 6</u> :	"Disobedience or an order or directive, whether written or
	oral."
<u>RULE 7</u> :	"Insubordination or disrespect toward a supervisory
	member on or off duty."
<u>RULE 8</u> :	"Disrespect to or maltreatment of any person, while on or
	off duty."
<u>RULE 30</u> :	"Leaving duty assignment of any person, while on or off

The Police Board of the City of Chicago, caused a hearing on these charges against Senior Data Entry Operator **SOMOCKI S. BRANNON**, Employee # 518601, to be heard by **JACQUELINE A. WALKER**, Hearing Officer of the Police Board of the City of Chicago, on April 26, 2002. Following the Hearing, the members of the Police Board read and reviewed the certified transcription of the proceedings of the hearing. **JACQUELINE A. WALKER**, Hearing Officer made an oral report and conferred with the Police Board before it rendered a decision.

As a result of the foregoing, the Police Board of the City of Chicago finds and determines that:

The Respondent was, at all times mentioned herein, a Senior Data Entry
 Operator employed by the Department of Police of the City of Chicago;

(2) The charges were filed, in writing, and a Notice, stating the time, date and place, when and where a hearing on the charges was to be held, together with a copy of the original charges were served upon the Respondent more than five (5) days prior to the hearing on the charges;

(3) Throughout the hearing, the Respondent appeared in person and was represented by legal counsel;

(4) The Respondent, Senior Data Entry Operator SOMOCKI S. BRANNON, Employee #518601, as charged herein, is <u>guilty</u> of violating, to-wit:

RULE 1: "Violation of any law or ordinance", in that: On or about March 29, 2000, at or near 1121 S. State Street, he

committed a battery while on duty, in that he made physical contact of an insulting or provoking nature with Sergeant Brian C. Oakes, by bumping his torso against Sergeant Oakes.

(5) The Respondent, Senior Data Entry Operator SOMOCKI S. BRANNON, Employee # 518601, as charged herein, is guilty of violating, to-wit:

 RULE 2:
 "Any action or conduct which impedes the

 Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or

 brings discredit upon the Department", in the

 following instances:

- (A) On or about March 29, 2000, at or near 1121 S. State Street, while on duty, he made physical contact of an insulting or provoking nature with Sergeant Brian
 C. Oakes, by bumping his torso against Sergeant Oakes.
- (B) On or about March 29, 2000, at or near 1121 S. State Street, while on duty, he failed to return to his unit after being given a direct order, one or more times, to do so by Sergeant Brian C. Oakes.
- (C) On or about March 29, 2000, at or near 1121 S. State Street, while on duty, he disobeyed an order or directive when he failed to retrieve his personal belongings and return to Room 405, after being given a direct order to do so by Sergeant Brian C. Oakes.
- (D) On or about March 29, 2000, at or near 1121 S. State Street, while on duty, he left his assigned work station without being properly relieved or without prior authorization.

- (E) On or about February, February 8, 2001, he was found guilty of the offense of battery.
- (6) The Respondent, Senior Data Entry Operator SOMOCKI S. BRANNON,Employee # 518601, as charged herein, is guilty of violating, to-wit:
 - **<u>RULE 6</u>** "Disobedience of any order or directive, whether written or oral", in the following instances:
 - (A) On or about March 29, 2000, at or near 1121 S. State Street, while on duty, he disobeyed an order or directive when he failed to return to his unit after being given a direct order to do so by Sergeant Brian C. Oakes, one or more times.

(B) On or about March 29, 2000, at or near 1121 S. State Street, while on duty, he disobeyed an order or directive when he failed to retrieve his personal belongings and return to Room 405, after being give a direct order to do so by Sergeant Brian C. Oakes.

- (7) The Respondent, Senior Data Entry Operator SOMOCKI S. BRANNON,Employee # 518601, as charged herein, is guilty of violating, to-wit:
 - **<u>RULE 7</u>**: "Insubordination or disrespect toward a supervisory member on or off duty", in that:

On or about March 29, 2000, at or near 1121 S. State Street, while on duty, he engaged in insubordination or disrespect toward a supervisory member, in that he failed to acknowledge Sergeant Brian C. Oakes, who had instructed him to return to his work area, and instead he approached Sergeant Oakes and bumped Sergeant Oakes' torso with his.

- (8) The Respondent, Senior Data Entry Operator SOMOCKI S. BRANNON, Employee # 518601, as charged herein, is guilty of violating, to-wit:
 - **<u>RULE 8</u>** "Disrespect to or maltreatment of any person, while on or off duty", in the following instances:

(A) On or about March 29, 2000, at or near 1121 S. State Street, while on duty, he disrespected or maltreated Sergeant Brian C. Oakes, in that he made physical contact of an insulting or provoking nature with Sergeant Oakes by bumping his torso against that of Sergeant Oakes.

- (B) On or about March 29, 2000, at or near 1121 S. State Street, while on duty, he engaged in insubordination or disrespect toward a supervisory member, in that he failed to acknowledge Sergeant Brian C. Oakes, who had instructed him to return to his work area, and instead he approached Sergeant Oakes and bumped his torso against that of Sergeant Oakes.
- (9) The Respondent, Senior Data Entry Operator SOMOCKI S. BRANNON, Employee # 518601, as charged herein, is guilty of violating, to-wit:
 - **<u>RULE 30</u>**: "Leaving duty assignment of any person, while on or off duty", in that:

On or about March 29, 2000, at or near 1121 S. State Street, while on duty, he left his assigned workstation without being properly relieved or without proper authorization.

BY REASON of the findings of fact and of guilty herein, cause exists for the suspension of Respondent, Civilian Senior Data Entry Operator **SOMOCKI S**.

BRANNON, Employee # 518601, from the Department of Police and from the services

of the City of Chicago from January 8, 2002 to and including July 7, 2002.


