FINDINGS AND DECISION

On February 5, 2002, the Superintendent of Police filed charges with the Police Board of the City of Chicago, seeking the termination of Property Custodian **REGINALD ITTIEWONE**, Employee # 309816, hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Respondent" for violation of the following rules:

RULE 1: "Violation of any law or ordinance."

RULE 2: "Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department."

The Police Board of the City of Chicago, caused a hearing on these charges against **REGINALD ITTIEWONE**, Employee # 309816, to be heard by **JACQUELINE A. WALKER**, Hearing Officer of the Police Board of the City of Chicago, on July 16, 2002. Following the Hearing, the members of the Police Board read and reviewed the certified transcription of the proceedings of the hearing.

JACQUELINE A. WALKER, Hearing Officer made an oral report and conferred with the Police Board before it rendered a decision.

As a result of the foregoing, the Police Board of the City of Chicago finds and determines that:

(1) The Respondent was, at all times mentioned herein, a Property Custodian employed by the Department of Police of the City of Chicago;

(2) The charges were filed, in writing, and a Notice, stating the time, date and place, when and where a hearing on the charges was to be held, together with a copy of the original charges were served upon the Respondent more than five (5) days prior to the hearing on the charges;

(3) Throughout the hearing, the Respondent appeared in person and was represented by legal counsel;

(4) Respondent, Property Custodian **REGINALD ITTIEWONE**, Employee # 309816, as charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to-wit:

RULE 1- “Violation of any law or ordinance”, in that:

On or about October 4, 2001, at 3920 South Michigan in the Evidence and Recovered Property Section Bulk Storage Warehouse, he committed the offense of theft, in that he obtained unauthorized control over property of the Chicago Police Department, which was a bag of bath products, with the intention of depriving the Department permanently of the benefit of the property, thereby violating Chapter 720 ILCS 5/16—1 (a)(1) and/or 5/16-1(a)(5).


(5) Respondent, Property Custodian **REGINALD ITTIEWONE**, Employee # 309816, as charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to-wit:

RULE 2: “Any action or conduct which impedes the Department’s efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department,” in that:

On or about October 4, 2001, at 3920 South Michigan in the Evidence and Recovered Property Section Bulk Storage Warehouse, he committed the offense of theft, in that he obtained unauthorized control over property of the Chicago Police Department, which was a bag of bath products, with the intention of depriving the Department permanently of the benefit of the property, thereby violating the law.

BY REASON of the findings of fact and of guilt herein, cause exists for the termination of Respondent, Property Custodian **REGINALD ITTIEWONE**, Employee # 309816, from the Department of Police and from the services of the City of Chicago.


