FINDINGS AND DECISION

On or about April1, 2003, the Superintendent of Police filed charges with the Police Board of the City of Chicago, seeking the termination of Detective **JANICE R. GOVERN**, Star # 20619, hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Respondent" for violation of the following rules:

RULE 2: "Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department."

RULE 5: "Failure to perform any duty."

RULE 14: "Making a false report, written or oral."

RULE 21: "Failure to report promptly to the Department any information concerning any crime or other unlawful action."

The Police Board of the City of Chicago caused a hearing on these charges against Detective JANICE R. GOVERN, Star # 20619, to be heard by JACQUELINE A. WALKER, Hearing Officer of the Police Board of the City of Chicago, on September 9, 2003, September 12, 2003 and October 2, 2003. Following the Hearing, the members of the Police Board read and reviewed the certified transcription of the proceedings of the hearing and viewed the videotapes of the proceedings.

JACQUELINE A. WALKER, Hearing Officer made an oral report and conferred with the Police Board before it rendered a decision.

As a result of the foregoing, the Police Board of the City of Chicago finds and determines that:

- (1) The Respondent was, at all times mentioned herein, a Detective employed by the Department of Police of the City of Chicago;
- (2) The charges were filed, in writing, and a Notice, stating the time, date and place, when and where a hearing on the charges was to be held, together with a copy of the original charges were served upon the Respondent more than five (5) days prior to the hearing on the charges;
- (3) Throughout the hearing, the Respondent appeared in person and was represented by legal counsel;
- (4) Respondent, Detective **JANICE R. GOVERN**, Star #20619, as charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to-wit:
 - **RULE 2**: "Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department," in the following instances:
 - (A) On or about August 25, 2001, while on duty and in the vicinity of a Dominick's food store located at or near 2101 East 71st Street, Chicago, Illinois, after learning that a bank robbery was in progress or had just been committed, she failed to take the appropriate police action, including, but not limited to: making the required notifications

to the Department; attempting to arrest the offender(s); preserving the crime scene for evidence collection and processing; locating, identifying and/or interviewing witnesses; o btaining a description of the offender(s); identifying herself and providing information to police units arriving on the scene; and /or notifying the Department prior to leaving the scene.

- (B)On or about December 10, 2001, while in the vicinity of 3510 South

 Michigan Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, she gave a statement to the

 Internal Affairs Division that contained false information.
- (5) The Respondent, Detective **JANICE R. GOVERN**, Star #20619, as charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to-wit:

RULE 5: "Failure to perform any duty", in that:

On or about August 25, 2001, at approximately 1245 hours, while on duty and in the vicinity of a Dominick's food store, located at or near 2101 East 71st Street, Chicago, Illinois, after learning a bank robbery was in progress or had just been committed, she failed to take appropriate police action, including, but not limited to: making the required notifications to the Department; attempting to arrest the offender(s); preserving the crime scene for evidence collection and processing; locating, identifying and/or interviewing witnesses; obtaining a description of the offender(s); identifying herself and providing information to police units arriving on the scene; and /or notifying the Department prior to leaving the scene.

(6) The Respondent, Detective JANICE R. GOVERN, Star #20619, as charged

herein, is guilty of violating, to-wit:

RULE 14: "Making a false report, written or oral", in that:

On or about December 10, 2001, while in the vicinity of 3510 South Michigan Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, she gave a statement containing false information to the Internal Affairs Division.

(7) The Respondent, Detective **JANICE R. GOVERN**, Star # 20619, as charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to-wit:

RULE 21: "Failure to report promptly to the Department any information concerning any crime or other unlawful action", in that:

On or about August 25, 2001, at approximately 1245 hours, while on duty and in the vicinity of a Dominick's food store located at or near 2101 East 71st Street, Chicago, Illinois, after learning that a bank robbery was in progress or had just been committed, she failed to report promptly to the Department any information concerning the robbery.

BY REASON of the findings of fact and of guilt herein, cause exists for the suspension of Respondent, Detective JANICE R. GOVERN, Star # 20619, from the Department of Police and from the services of the City of Chicago from April 3, 2003 to April 2, 2005.

DECISION

The members of the Police Board, having read and reviewed the certified copy of the transcription of the hearing, having viewed the videotapes of the hearing, having received the oral report of the Hearing Officer, **JACQUELINE A. WALKER**, and having conferred with the Hearing Officer on the credibility of the witnesses and the evidence, hereby adopt all findings herein, and, in reaching its decision as to the penalty imposed, the Board has taken into account not only the facts of this case but also the Respondent's complimentary and disciplinary history, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A; and,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Respondent, Detective **JANICE R. GOVERN**, Star # 20619, as a result of having been found guilty of the charges in Police Board Case No. 03-2510, is hereby suspended from her position as a Detective, and from the services of the City of Chicago, from April 3, 2003, to and including April 2, 2005.
