CHARGES

Police Office Robert Rubio, Star Number 19833, is charged with violating the following rules contained in Article V of the Rules and Regulations of the Chicago Police Department, which were in full force and effect on the date of the alleged violations:

Rule 1: Violation of any law or ordinance.

Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its

policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.

Rule 6: Disobedience of an order or directive, whether written or oral.

SPECIFICATIONS

1. Police Officer Robert Rubio, Star Number 19833, is charged with violating Rule 1, "Violation of any law or ordinance," in the following instance:

Count I: On or about 9 May 2002, Officer Rubio rendered a urine specimen which

contained methandrostenolone metabolite, an anabolic steroid, thereby violating Chapter 720 ILCS 570/402 by possessing some amount of methandrostenolone

on or before 9 May 2002.

Count II: On or about 9 May 2002, Officer Rubio rendered a urine specimen which

contained stanozolol metabolite, an anabolic steroid, thereby violating Chapter 720 ILCS 570/402 by possessing some amount of stanozolol on or before 9 May

2002.

2. Police Officer Robert Rubio, Star Number 19833, is charged with violating Rule 2, "Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department," in the following instances:

Count I: On or about 8 January 2001, Officer Rubio accompanied Robert Labay

to the residence of a police officer who had previously investigated Labay for

selling narcotics and /or steroids.

Count II: From February 2001 to the present, or for some period of time therein, Officer

Rubio maintained a personal relationship with Robert Labay despite Officer Rubio's knowledge that Labay had been arrested for drug related charges

on or about February 16, 2001.

Count III:

On or about 9 May 2002, Officer Rubio rendered a urine specimen which

contained methandrostenolone metabolite, an anabolic steroid.

Count IV:

On or about 9 May 2002, Officer Rubio rendered a urine specimen which

contained stanozolol metabolite, an anabolic steroid.

3. Police Officer Robert Rubio, Star Number 19833, is charged with violating Rule 6, "disobedience or an order or directive, whether written or oral," in one or more of the following instance:

Count I:

On or about 9 May 2002, Officer Rubio rendered a urine specimen which

contained methandrostenolone metabolite, an anabolic steroid, thereby violating

General Order 90-5, Article III, Section B.

Count II:

On or about 9 May 2002, Officer Rubio rendered a urine specimen which

contained stanozolol metabolite, an anabolic steroid, thereby violating General

Order 90-5, Article III, Section B.
