FINDINGS & DECISION

On March 2, 2004, the Superintendent of Police filed charges with the Police Board of the City of Chicago against Crossing Guard Carlous Buis, Star #347, (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Respondent") seeking his discharge for violating the following Rules:

Rule 1: Violation of any law or ordinance.

<u>Rule 2</u>: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.

<u>Rule 38</u>: Unlawful or unnecessary use or display of a weapon.

The Police Board of the City of Chicago caused a hearing on these charges against Crossing Guard Carlous Buis before Michael G. Berland, Hearing Officer of the Police Board of the City of Chicago on August 4, 2004 and August 17, 2004.

Following the hearing, the members of the Police Board read and reviewed the certified transcription of the proceedings of the hearing. Michael G. Berland, Hearing Officer, made an oral report and conferred with the Police Board before it rendered a decision.

The Police Board of the City of Chicago, as a result of its

investigation of the charges, finds and determines that:

1. The Respondent was at all times a Crossing Guard employed by the Department of Police of the City of Chicago.

2. The charges were filed in writing and a Notice, stating the time, date and place, when and where a hearing of the charges was to be held, together with a copy of the original charges, was served upon the Respondent more than five (5) days prior to the hearing on the charges.

3. The hearing was conducted before Michael G. Berland, Hearing Officer of the Police Board of the City of Chicago, on August 4, 2004 and August 17, 2004.

4. Throughout the hearing the Respondent did appear in person and was represented by a union representative.

5. Respondent Crossing Guard Carlous Buis, Star # 347, charged herein, contrary to the Rules and Regulations, is <u>guilty</u> of violating, to wit:

<u>Rule 1</u>: Violation of any law or ordinance.

A. On or about January 1, 2003, at approximately 0030 hours, at or near 8746 S. Baltimore, Chicago, Illinois, Crossing Guard Buis, while off duty, knowingly carried and/or concealed on or about his person at a location other than his abode or fixed place of business, a Herstal Belgique, Browning, 9 mm semiautomatic pistol and/or revolver, Serial Number 89912A, in violation of Illinois Compiled Statues Chapter 720 Section 5/24-

1.6(a)(1).

B. On or about January 1, 2003, at approximately 0030 hours, at or near 8746 S. Baltimore, Chicago, Illinois, Crossing Guard Buis, while off duty, without lawful authority carried and/or maintained and/or concealed on or about his person at a location other than his abode or fixed place of business, a Herstal Belgique, Browning, 9 mm semi-automatic pistol and revolver, Serial Number 89912A, in violation of Chapter 8 of the Chicago Municipal Code, Section 20-10.

6. Respondent Crossing Guard Carlous Buis, Star#347, charged herein, contrary to the Rules and Regulations, is <u>guilty</u> of violating, to wit:

<u>Rule 2</u>: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's . efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.

A. On or about January 1, 2003, at approximately 0030 hours, at or near 8746 S. Baltimore, Chicago, Illinois, Crossing Guard Buis, while off duty, brought discredit upon the Department and impeded the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals in that he, among other things, without lawful authority knowingly carried and/or concealed on or about his person at a location other than his abode or fixed place of business a Herstal Belgique, Browning, 9 mm semi-automatic pistol and revolver, Serial Number 89912A.

B. On or about January 1, 2003, at approximately 0030 hours,

at or near 8746 S. Baltimore, Chicago, Illinois, Crossing Guard Buis, while off duty, brought discredit upon the Department and impeded the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals in that he, among other things, without lawful authority and/or necessity used or displayed a Herstal Belgique, Browning, 9 mm semi-automatic pistol and or revolver, Serial Number 89912A.

7. Respondent Crossing Guard Carlous Buis, Star #347, charged herein, contrary to the Rules and Regulations, is <u>guilty</u> of violating, to wit:

Rule 38: Unlawful or unnecessary use or display of a weapon.

A. On or about January 1, 2003, at approximately 0030 hours, at or near 8746 S. Baltimore, Chicago, Illinois, Crossing Guard Buis, while off duty, and without lawful authority and/or necessity used or displayed a Herstal Belgique, Browning, 9 mm semi-automatic pistol and revolver, Serial Number 89912A.

By reason of the findings of fact that the Respondent Crossing Guard Carlous Buis, Star #347, is <u>guilty</u> of violations of Rules 1, 2, and 38, cause exists for the termination of Carlous Buis, from his position as a Crossing Guard with the Department of Police and from the services of the City of Chicago.




