FINDINGS AND DECISION

On March 2, 2004, the Superintendent of Police filed with the Police Board of the City of Chicago charges against Police Officer Bryan Vander Mey, Star No. 13972 (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Respondent"), for violating the following rules:

Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.

<u>Rule 6</u>: Disobedience of an order or directive, whether written or oral.

Rule 14: Making a false report, written or oral.

The Police Board caused a hearing on these charges against Police Officer Bryan Vander Mey, Star No. 13972, to be had before Thomas E. Johnson, Hearing Officer of the Police Board, on August 21, August 22, and September 8, 2006.

Following the hearing, the members of the Police Board read and reviewed the certified transcription of the hearing and viewed the video-recording of the hearing. Thomas E. Johnson, Hearing Officer, made an oral report to and conferred with the Police Board before it rendered a decision.

The Police Board of the City of Chicago, as a result of its hearing of the charges, finds and determines that:

- The Respondent was at all times mentioned herein employed as a police officer by the Department of Police of the City of Chicago.
- 2. The charges were filed in writing and a Notice, stating the time, date and place, when and where a hearing of the charges was to be held, together with a copy of the original charges, was served upon the Respondent more than five (5) days prior to the hearing on the charges.
- 3. The hearing was conducted before Thomas E. Johnson, Hearing Officer of the Police Board of the City of Chicago, on August 21, August 22, and September 8, 2006.
- 4. Throughout the hearing, the Respondent was present and represented by counsel of his choice.
- 5. The Respondent Police Officer Bryan Vander Mey, Star No. 13972, charged herein, is guilty of violating, to wit:
 - Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.

<u>Count I</u>: On April 17, 2003, at approximately 2330 hours, in the vicinity of 1230 North Burling Street, Chicago, Officer Vander Mey, while on duty, discharged oleoresin capsicum (OC) spray into a vehicle without supervisory approval.

Count II: On April 17, 2003, at approximately 2330 hours, in the vicinity of 1230 North Burling Street, Chicago, Officer Vander Mey, while on duty, physically maltreated a citizen on the street in front of numerous citizens.

<u>Count III</u>: On June 4, 2003, at approximately 1600 hours, at the Office of Professional Standards, Officer Vander Mey gave a statement that contained false

information and responded to questions in a manner intended to impede and/or obstruct the Department's investigation of the incident occurring on April 17, 2003, in the vicinity of 1230 North Burling Street, Chicago.

- 6. The Respondent Police Officer Bryan Vander Mey, Star
- No. 13972, charged herein, is guilty of violating, to wit:
 - Rule 6: Disobedience of an order or directive, whether written or oral.

On April 17, 2003, at approximately 2330 hours, in the vicinity of 1230 North Burling Street, Chicago, Officer Vander Mey, while on duty, failed to adhere to the provisions of General Order 02-08, addendum 2, section III-B1(d)1 in that he discharged oleoresin capsicum (OC) spray into a vehicle without supervisory approval as required.

- 7. The Respondent Police Officer Bryan Vander Mey, Star
- No. 13972, charged herein, is guilty of violating, to wit:

On April 17, 2003, at approximately 2330 hours, in the vicinity of 1230 North Burling Street, Chicago, Officer Vander Mey, while on duty, physically maltreated Rondell Freeman when he punched and kicked Freeman about the body.

- 8. The Respondent Police Officer Bryan Vander Mey, Star
- No. 13972, charged herein, is guilty of violating, to wit:
 - Rule 14: Making a false report, written or oral.

<u>Count I</u>: On June 4, 2003, at approximately 1600 hours, at the Office of Professional Standards, Officer Vander Mey gave a statement that contained false information in that he denied playing any part in removing Rondell Freeman from a vehicle on April 17, 2003, at

approximately 2330 hours, in the vicinity of 1230 North Burling Street, Chicago.

Count II: On June 4, 2003, at approximately 1600 hours, at the Office of Professional Standards, Officer Vander Mey gave a statement that contained false information in that he denied discharging oleoresin capsicum (OC) spray into a vehicle on April 17, 2003, at approximately 2330 hours, in the vicinity of 1230 North Burling Street, Chicago.

Count III: On June 4, 2003, at approximately 1600 hours, at the Office of Professional Standards, Officer Vander Mey gave a statement that contained false information in that he denied being able to recognize himself on tape while viewing video footage of the incident occurring on April 17, 2003, at approximately 2330 hours, in the vicinity of 1230 North Burling Street, Chicago.

Count IV: On June 4, 2003, at approximately 1600 hours, at the Office of Professional Standards, Officer Vander Mey gave a statement that contained false information in that he denied knowing where he parked the squadrol on April 17, 2003, at approximately 2330 hours, in the vicinity of 1230 North Burling Street, Chicago.

By reason of the findings of fact that the Respondent is guilty of violating Rules 2, 6, 8, and 14, cause exists for the suspension of the Respondent from his position as a police officer with the Department of Police, and from the services of the City of Chicago, for a period from March 3, 2004, to and including March 2, 2007.
