FINDINGS AND DECISION

On January 11, 2006, the Superintendent of Police filed charges with the Police Board of the City of Chicago against Police Officer Patricia Hill, Star No. 4166, (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Respondent") seeking her discharge for violating the following Rules:

Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.

<u>Rule 6</u>: Disobedience of an order or directive, whether written or oral.

The Police Board of the City of Chicago caused a hearing on these charges against Police Officer Patricia Hill to be had before Michael G. Berland, Hearing Officer of the Police Board of the City of Chicago, on June 14 and July 5, 2006.

Following the hearing, the members of the Police Board read and reviewed the certified transcription of the hearing and viewed the video-recording of the hearing. Michael G. Berland, Hearing Officer, made an oral report to and conferred with the Police Board before it rendered a decision.

The Police Board of the City of Chicago, as a result of its hearing of the charges, finds and determines that:

- 1. The Respondent was, at all times mentioned herein, a police officer employed by the Department of Police of the City of Chicago.
- 2. The charges were filed in writing and a Notice, stating the time, date, and place, when and where a hearing of the charges was to be held, together with a copy of the original charges, were served upon the Respondent more than five (5) days prior to the initial hearing on the charges.
- 3. The hearing was conducted on June 14 and July 5, 2006, before Michael G. Berland, Hearing Officer of the Police Board of the City of Chicago.
- 4. Throughout the hearing, the Respondent appeared in person and was represented by counsel of her choice.
- 5. The Respondent, Police Officer Patricia Hill, Star No. 4166, charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to wit:
 - Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.

On or about September 14, 2004, at U.S. Occupational Health, Inc., 205 West Randolph Street, Room 720, Chicago, Police Officer Patricia Hill refused to participate in a mandatory physical examination, although Sergeant Laurel Bresnahan had given her a direct order to participate in the aforementioned examination.

6. The Respondent, Police Officer Patricia Hill, Star No. 4166, charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to wit:

Rule 6: Disobedience of an order or directive, whether written or oral.

On or about September 14, 2004, at U.S. Occupational Health, Inc., 205 West Randolph Street, Room 720, Chicago, Police Officer Patricia Hill refused to participate in a mandatory physical examination, thereby failing to comply with a direct order given by Sergeant Laurel Bresnahan to participate in the aforementioned examination.

By reason of the findings of fact that Respondent is guilty of violating Rules 2 and 6, cause exists for the suspension of Respondent from her position as a police officer with the Department of Police, and from the services of the City of Chicago, for a period from January 13, 2006, to and including April 12, 2006.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Respondent, Police Officer Patricia Hill, Star No. 4166, as a result of having been found guilty of charges in Police Board Case No. 06 PB 2584, be and hereby is suspended from her position as a police officer with the Department of Police, and from the services of the City of Chicago, for a period from 13 January 2006 to and including 12 April 2006 (three months)
