### FINDINGS AND DECISION

On January 20, 2006 the Superintendent of Police filed charges with the Police Board of the City of Chicago against Lieutenant Richard Guerrero, Star No. 428 (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Respondent"), for violating the following rules:

Rule 1: Violation of any law or ordinance.

Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.

The Police Board of the City of Chicago caused a hearing on these charges against Lieutenant Richard Guerrero, Star No. 428, to be had before Thomas E. Johnson, Hearing Officer of the Police Board of the City of Chicago, on May 22, 2006, and May 26, 2006.

Following the hearing, the members of the Police Board read and reviewed the certified transcription of the hearing and viewed the video-recording of the hearing. Thomas E. Johnson, Hearing Officer, made an oral report to and conferred with the Police Board before it rendered a decision.

The Police Board of the City of Chicago, as a result of its hearing of the charges, finds and determines that:

- The Respondent was at all times mentioned herein employed as a lieutenant of police by the Department of Police of the City of Chicago.
- 2. The charges were filed in writing and a Notice, stating the time, date and place, when and where a hearing of the charges was to be held, together with a copy of the original charges, was served upon the Respondent more than five (5) days prior to the hearing on the charges.
- 3. The hearing was conducted before Thomas E. Johnson, Hearing Officer of the Police Board of the City of Chicago, on May 22, 2006, and May 26, 2006.
- 4. Throughout the hearing, the Respondent was present and represented by counsel of his choice.
- 5. The Respondent, Lieutenant Richard Guerrero, Star No. 428, charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to wit:
  - Rule 1: Violation of any law or ordinance.

On or about April 19, 2005, Lieutenant Richard Guerrero committed the offense of Harassment by Telephone, 720 ILCS 135/1-1, in that he placed approximately ten unsolicited telephone calls to Marylu Chavez.

- 6. The Respondent, Lieutenant Richard Guerrero, Star No. 428, charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to wit:
  - Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.

Count I: On or about April 19, 2005, Lieutenant Richard
Guerrero, while both on and off duty, placed

approximately ten unsolicited telephone calls to Marylu Chavez.

<u>Count II</u>: On or about April 19, 2005, Lieutenant Richard Guerrero, while on duty, obtained the telephone number of Marylu Chavez from a report made at the 13<sup>th</sup> District police station.

Count III: On or about November 4, 2005, Lieutenant Richard Guerrero was found guilty in the Circuit Court of Cook County of the offense of Harassment by Telephone, 720 ILCS 135/1-1.

By reason of the findings of fact that the Respondent is guilty of violating Rules 1 and 2, cause exists for the suspension of the Respondent from his position as a lieutenant of police with the Department of Police, and from the services of the City of Chicago, for a period from January 26, 2006 to and including January 25, 2007.


