## FINDINGS

On May 8, 2006, the superintendent of police filed with the Police Board of the City of Chicago charges against Police Officer Frederick Driver, Star No. 4299 (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Respondent"), recommending that the Respondent be discharged from the Chicago Police Department for violating the following Rules of Conduct:

Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.

Rule 6: Disobedience of an order or directive, whether written or oral.

Rule 23: Failure to obey Department orders concerning other employment, occupation, or profession.

The Police Board caused a hearing on these charges against Police Officer Frederick Driver to be had before Michael G. Berland, Hearing Officer of the Police Board, on June 27, 2007.

Following the hearing, the members of the Police Board read and reviewed the certified transcription of the hearing and viewed the video-recording of the hearing. Michael G. Berland, Hearing officer, made an oral report to and conferred with the Police Board before it rendered a decision.

The Police Board of the City of Chicago, as a result of its hearing of the charges, finds and determines that:

1. The Respondent was at all times mentioned herein employed as a police officer by the Department of Police of the City of Chicago.
2. The charges were filed in writing and a Notice, stating the time, date, and place, when and where a hearing of the charges was to be held, together with a copy of the original charges, was served upon the Respondent more than five (5) days prior to the hearing on the charges.
3. Throughout the hearing the Respondent appeared in person and was represented by legal counsel.
4. The Respondent, Police Officer Frederick Driver, Star No. 4299, charged herein, is guilty of violating, to wit:

Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.

From on or about January 25, 2005, to and including May 18, 2005, or for some period of time therein, he engaged in secondary employment as a security guard at Oglesby School, 7646 South Green Street, Chicago, while on the medical roll of the Chicago Police Department.
5. The Respondent, Police Officer Frederick Driver, Star No. 4299, charged herein, is guilty of violating, to wit:

Rule 6: Disobedience of an order or directive, whether written or oral.

From on or about January 25, 2005, to and including May 18, 2005, or for some period of time therein, he engaged in secondary employment as a security guard at Oglesby School, 7646 South Green Street, Chicago, while on the medical roll of the Chicago Police Department, thereby violating General Order 89-8, section IV.K.

6. The Respondent, Police Officer Frederick Driver, Star No. 4299, charged herein, is guilty of violating, to wit:

Rule 23: Failure to obey Department orders concerning other employment, occupation, or profession.

From on or about January 25, 2005, to and including May 18, 2005, or for some period of time therein, he engaged in secondary employment as a security guard at Oglesby School, 7646 South Green Street, Chicago, while on the medical roll of the Chicago Police Department.

By reason of the findings of fact and guilt set forth herein, cause exists for the suspension of the Respondent, Police Officer Frederick Driver, Star No. 4299, from his position as a police officer with the Department of Police, and from the services of the City of Chicago, from May 9, 2006, to and including September 3, 2007.

## DECISION

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Respondent, Police Officer Frederick Driver, Star No. 4299, as a result of having been found guilty of charges in Police Board Case No. 06 PB 2606, be and hereby is suspended from his position as a police officer with the Department of Police, and from the services of the City of Chicago, for a period from 09 May 2006 to and including 03 September 2007
