FINDINGS

On May 11, 2006, the Superintendent of Police filed with the Police Board of the City of Chicago charges against Police Officer Sebastian Q. Weaver, Star No. 17209 (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Respondent"), seeking his discharge for violating the following Rules of Conduct:

- Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.
- <u>Rule 6</u>: Disobedience of an order or directive, whether written or oral.
- Rule 23: Failure to obey Department orders concerning other employment, occupation, or profession.

The Police Board caused a hearing on these charges against Police Officer Sebastian Q. Weaver to be had before Thomas E. Johnson, Hearing Officer of the Police Board, on September 24 and October 22, 2007.

Following the hearing, the members of the Police Board read and reviewed the certified transcription of the hearing and viewed the video-recording of the hearing. Thomas E. Johnson, Hearing Officer, made an oral report to and conferred with the Police Board before it rendered a decision.

The Police Board of the City of Chicago, as a result of its hearing of the charges, finds and determines that:

- 1. The Respondent was at all times mentioned herein employed as a police officer by the Department of Police of the City of Chicago.
- 2. The charges were filed in writing and a Notice, stating the time, date, and place, when and where a hearing of the charges was to be held, together with a copy of the original charges, was served upon the Respondent more than five (5) days prior to the hearing on the charges.
- 3. The Respondent appeared throughout the hearing and was represented by legal counsel.
- 4. The Respondent, Police Officer Sebastian Q. Weaver,
 Star No. 17209, charged herein, is quilty of violating, to wit:
 - Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.

in that:

From on or about November 4, 2004, through May 31, 2005, or for some period of time therein, he engaged in secondary employment while on the medical roll of the Chicago Police Department, in that he worked for the Chicago Board of Education, thereby impeding the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals and/or bringing discredit upon the Department.

- 5. The Respondent, Police Officer Sebastian Q. Weaver, Star No. 17209, charged herein, is guilty of violating, to wit:
 - <u>Rule 6</u>: Disobedience of an order or directive, whether written or oral.

in that:

From on or about November 4, 2004, through May 31, 2005, or for some period of time therein, he engaged in secondary employment while on the medical roll of the Chicago Police Department, in that he worked for the Chicago Board of Education, thereby violating General Order 89-08, section IV.K.

6. The Respondent, Police Officer Sebastian Q. Weaver,
Star No. 17209, charged herein, is guilty of violating, to wit:

Rule 23: Failure to obey Department orders concerning other employment, occupation, or profession.

in that:

From on or about November 4, 2004, through May 31, 2005, or for some period of time therein, he engaged in secondary employment while on the medical roll of the Chicago Police Department, in that he worked for the Chicago Board of Education, thereby failing to obey Department orders concerning other employment, occupation, or profession.

By reason of the findings of fact and guilt herein, cause exists for the discharge of the Respondent, Police Officer Sebastian Q. Weaver, Star No. 17209, from his position as a police officer with the Department of Police, and from the services of the City of Chicago.

DECISION


