#### **FINDINGS**

On September 1, 2006, the Superintendent of Police filed charges with the Police

Board of the City of Chicago seeking the discharge of POLICE OFFICER FABIAN

MARTINEZ III, Star No. 14671, hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Respondent,"

for violation of the following rules:

<u>RULE 1:</u>	Violation of any law or ordinance.
<b>RULE 2</b> :	Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's
	efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit
	upon the Department.
<u>RULE 7</u> :	Insubordination or disrespect toward a supervisory member on or off duty.

**<u>RULE 14</u>**: Making a false report, written or oral.

The Police Board of the City of Chicago caused a hearing on these charges

against **POLICE OFFICER FABIAN MARTINEZ III, Star No. 14671**, to be heard by **JACQUELINE A. WALKER**, Hearing Officer of the Police Board of the City of Chicago, on February 6, 2007 and February 28, 2007. Following the hearing, the members of the Police Board read and reviewed the certified transcription of the proceedings of the hearing and viewed the video-recording of the hearing.

**JACQUELINE A. WALKER,** Hearing Officer, made an oral report to and conferred with the Police Board before it rendered a decision.

As a result of the foregoing, the Police Board of the City of Chicago finds and determines that:

 The Respondent was, at all times mentioned herein, a police officer employed by the Department of Police of the City of Chicago;

(2) The charges were filed in writing, and a Notice, stating the time, date and place, when and where a hearing on the charges was to be held, together with a copy of the original charges, was served upon the Respondent more than five (5) days prior to the hearing on the charges;

(3) Throughout the hearing, the Respondent appeared in person and was represented by legal counsel;

(4) Respondent, **POLICE OFFICER FABIAN MARTINEZ III, Star No. 14671**, as charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to-wit:

**<u>RULE 1:</u>** "Violation of any law or ordinance," in the following instances:

- A) On or about December 19, 2004, at approximately 3:00 a.m., in the vicinity of 6834 West Higgins, he was involved in a motor vehicle accident and failed to remain at the scene of the accident in violation of 625 ILCS 5/11-402.
- B) On or about December 19, 2004, at approximately 3:00 a.m., in the vicinity of 6834 West Higgins, he was involved in a motor vehicle accident resulting in damage to a vehicle and failed to give information and render aid in violation of 625 ILCS 5/11-

403.

- C) On or about December 19, 2004, at approximately 3:00 a.m., in the vicinity of 6834 West Higgins, he was the driver of a vehicle involved in an accident resulting in injury to or death of any person, or in damage to property, including his own, in excess of \$500, and failed to report the accident to the Administrator of the Illinois Safety and Family Financial Responsibility Law within ten days in violation of 625 ILCS 5/11-406.
- D) On or about December 19, 2004, at approximately 3:00 a.m. in the vicinity of 6834 West Higgins, he was the driver of a vehicle involved in an accident and failed to give notice of the accident by the fastest available means of communication to the local police department in violation of 625 ILCS 5/11 -407.
- E) On or about December 20, 2004, he committed disorderly conduct when he knowingly transmitted or caused to be transmitted in any manner to any peace officer, public officer or public employee a report to the effect that an offense will be committed, is being committed, or has been committed, knowing at the time of such transmission that there is no reasonable ground for believing that such an offense will be committed, is being committed, or has been committed, in violation of 720 ILCS 5/26-1.

(5) Respondent, POLICE OFFICER FABIAN MARTINEZ III, Star No.

14671, as charged herein, is guilty of violating, to-wit:

**<u>RULE 2</u>**: "Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department," in the following instances:

- A) On or about December 19, 2004, at approximately 3:00 a.m., in the vicinity of 6834 West Higgins, he was involved in a motor vehicle accident and failed to remain at the scene of the accident to give information and/or render aid and/or determine if aid was required.
- B) On or about December 19, 2004, at approximately 3:00 a.m., in the vicinity of 6834 West Higgins, he was the driver of a vehicle involved in an accident resulting in injury to or death of any person, or in damage to property, including his own, in excess of \$500, and failed to report the accident to the Administrator of the Illinois Safety and Family Financial Responsibility Law within ten days.
- C) On or about December 19, 2004, at approximately 3:00 a.m. in the vicinity of 6834 West Higgins, he was the driver of a vehicle involved in an accident and failed to give notice of the accident to the local police department
- D) On or about December 20, 2004, at approximately 4:50 p.m., he
  falsely reported to the Chicago Police Department that his vehicle

was stolen.

E) On or about April 6, 2005, he refused to cooperate in an investigation being conducted by personnel from the Major Accident Investigations Unit.

(6) Respondent, POLICE OFFICER FABIAN MARTINEZ III, Star No.

14671, as charged herein, is guilty of violating, to-wit:

**<u>RULE 7</u>**: "Insubordination or disrespect toward a supervisory member on or off duty," in that:

On or about April 6, 2005, he refused to cooperate with Lieutenant Gerard Carroll in an investigation being conducted by the Major Accident Investigations Unit.

(7) Respondent, POLICE OFFICER FABIAN MARTINEZ III, Star No.14671, as charged herein, is <u>guilty</u> of violating, to-wit:

<u>RULE 14</u>: ""Making a false report, written or oral," in that:On or about December 20, 2004, at 4:50 p.m., he falsely reported to the Chicago Police Department that his vehicle was stolen.

**BY REASON** of the findings of fact and of guilt herein, cause exists for the discharge of Respondent, Police Officer Fabian Martinez, Star No. 14671, from his position as a police officer with the Department of Police, and from the services of the City of Chicago.




