## FINDINGS

On January 17, 2007, the Superintendent of Police filed with the Police Board of the City of Chicago charges against Police Officer Lonzo Edwards Jr., Star No. 13537 (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Respondent"), recommending that the Respondent be discharged from the Chicago Police Department for violating the following Rules of Conduct:

Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.

Rule 6: Disobedience of an order or directive, whether written or oral.

Rule 24: Failure to follow medical roll procedures.

Rule 28: Being absent from duty without proper authorization.

The Police Board caused a hearing on these charges against Police Officer Lonzo Edwards Jr. to be had before Michael G. Berland, Hearing Officer of the Police Board, on October 23, 2007.

Following the hearing, the members of the Police Board read and reviewed the certified transcription of the hearing and viewed the video-recording of the hearing. Michael G. Berland, Hearing Officer, made an oral report to and conferred with the Police Board before it rendered a decision.

The Police Board of the City of Chicago, as a result of its hearing of the charges, finds and determines that:

- 1. The Respondent was at all times mentioned herein employed as a police officer by the Department of Police of the City of Chicago.
- 2. The charges were filed in writing and a notice, stating the time, date, and place, when and where a hearing of the charges was to be held, together with a copy of the original charges, was served upon the Respondent more than five (5) days prior to the hearing on the charges.
- 3. Throughout the hearing the Respondent appeared in person and was represented by legal counsel.
- 4. The Respondent, Police Officer Lonzo Edwards Jr., Star No. 13537, charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to wit:
  - Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.

#### in that:

<u>Count I</u>: On or about October 4, 2004, he failed to report to Mercy Works as directed by Medical Services Section personnel, thereby impeding the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or bringing discredit upon the Department.

<u>Count II</u>: On or about October 5, 2004, he failed to report to the Medical Services Section as directed by Medical Services Section personnel, thereby impeding the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or bringing discredit upon the Department.

<u>Count III</u>: From on or about October 5, 2004, to April 28, 2005, or for some period of time therein, he remained on the medical roll without proper authorization, thereby impeding

the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or bringing discredit upon the Department.

- 5. The Respondent, Police Officer Lonzo Edwards Jr., Star No. 13537, charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to wit:
  - <u>Rule 6</u>: Disobedience of an order or directive, whether written or oral.

#### in that:

<u>Count I</u>: On or about October 4, 2004, he failed to report to Mercy Works as directed by Medical Services Section personnel, thereby disobeying an order or directive, whether written or oral.

<u>Count II</u>: On or about October 5, 2004, he failed to report to the Medical Services Section as directed by Medical Services Section personnel, thereby disobeying an order or directive, whether written or oral.

- 6. The Respondent, Police Officer Lonzo Edwards Jr., Star No. 13537, charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to wit:
  - Rule 24: Failure to follow medical roll procedures.

#### in that:

<u>Count I</u>: On or about October 4, 2004, he failed to report to Mercy Works as directed by Medical Services Section personnel, thereby failing to follow medical roll procedures.

<u>Count II</u>: On or about October 5, 2004, he failed to report to the Medical Services Section as directed by Medical Services Section personnel, thereby failing to follow medical roll procedures.

<u>Count III</u>: From on or about October 5, 2004, through April 28, 2005, or for some period of time therein, he remained on the medical roll without proper authorization, thereby failing to follow medical roll procedures.

7. The Respondent, Police Officer Lonzo Edwards Jr., Star No. 13537, charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to wit:

Rule 28: Being absent from duty without proper authorization.

in that:

From on or about October 5, 2004, through April 28, 2005, or for some period of time therein, he remained on the medical roll without proper authorization, thereby being absent from duty without proper authorization.

By reason of the findings of fact and guilt set forth herein, cause exists for the discharge of the Respondent, Police Officer Lonzo Edwards Jr., Star No. 13537, from his position as a police officer with the Department of Police, and from the services of the City of Chicago.




