FINDINGS

On April 4, 2007, the superintendent of police filed with the Police Board of the City of Chicago charges against Supervising Property Custodian Robert Vasquez, Employee No. 52428 (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Respondent"), recommending that the Respondent be discharged from the Chicago Police Department for violating the following Rules of Conduct:

Rule 1: Violation of any law or ordinance.

Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.

<u>Rule 6</u>: Disobedience of an order or directive, whether written or oral.

The Police Board caused a hearing on these charges against Supervising Property Custodian Robert Vasquez to be had before Michael G. Berland, Hearing Officer of the Police Board, on August 1, 2007.

Following the hearing, the members of the Police Board read and reviewed the certified transcription of the hearing and viewed the video-recording of the hearing. Michael G. Berland, Hearing Officer, made an oral report to and conferred with the Police Board before it rendered a decision.

The Police Board of the City of Chicago, as a result of its hearing of the charges, finds and determines that:

- 1. The Respondent was at all times mentioned herein employed as a supervising property custodian by the Department of Police of the City of Chicago.
- 2. The charges were filed in writing and a notice, stating the time, date, and place, when and where an initial hearing of the charges was to be held, together with a copy of the original charges, was served upon the Respondent more than five (5) days prior to the hearing on the charges.
- 3. The Respondent was properly notified of subsequent status hearings and the evidentiary hearing by first-class and certified U.S. mail to the address listed on the notice of charges. The Respondent did not appear at the status hearings held on May 23 and June 14, 2007, nor did the Respondent appear at the evidentiary hearing. The Respondent was not represented by legal counsel. The Hearing Officer proceeded with the evidentiary hearing in the Respondent's absence in accordance with the Police Board Rules of Procedure (section III.G).
- 4. The Respondent, Supervising Property Custodian Robert Vasquez, Employee No. 52428, charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to wit:

Rule 1: Violation of any law or ordinance.

On or about July 20, 2006, he provided a urine specimen that contained cocaine metabolites, and thus he possessed cocaine on or before July 20, 2006, in

violation of chapter 720 of the Illinois Compiled Statues, section 570/402.

- 5. The Respondent, Supervising Property Custodian Robert Vasquez, Employee No. 52428, charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to wit:
 - Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.

On or about July 20, 2006, he provided a urine specimen that contained cocaine metabolites.

- 6. The Respondent, Supervising Property Custodian Robert Vasquez, Employee No. 52428, charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to wit:
 - <u>Rule 6</u>: Disobedience of an order or directive, whether written or oral.

On or about July 20, 2006, he provided a urine specimen that contained cocaine metabolites, and thus he possessed cocaine on or before July 20, 2006, in violation of Administrative Special Order 05-01, article III, section B.

By reason of the findings of fact and guilt set forth herein, cause exists for the discharge of the Respondent, Supervising Property Custodian Robert Vasquez, Employee No. 52428, from his position with the Department of Police, and from the services of the City of Chicago.




