FINDINGS

On April 20, 2007, the Superintendent of Police filed with the Police Board of the City of Chicago charges against Police Officer MAHIR AFFANEH, Star No. 19612 (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Respondent"), recommending that the Respondent be discharged from the Chicago Police Department for violating the following Rules of Conduct:

RULE 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.

RULE 14: Making a false report, written or oral.

RULE 24: Failure to follow medical roll procedures.

The Police Board caused a hearing on these charges against Police Officer Mahir Affaneh to be had before JACQUELINE A. WALKER, Hearing Officer of the Police Board, on October 18 and October 26, 2007. Following the hearing, the members of the Police Board read and reviewed the certified transcription of the hearing and viewed the video-recording of the hearing. JACQUELINE A. WALKER, Hearing Officer, made an oral report to and conferred with the Police Board before it rendered a decision.

As a result of the foregoing, the Police Board of the City of Chicago finds and determines that:

- (1) The Respondent was, at all times mentioned herein, a police officer employed by the Department of Police of the City of Chicago.
- (2) The charges were filed, in writing, and a notice, stating the time, date and place, when and where a hearing on the charges was to be held, together with a copy of the original charges, were served upon the Respondent more than five (5) days prior to the hearing on the charges.
- (3) Throughout the hearing, the Respondent appeared in person and was represented by legal counsel.
- (4) The Respondent, Police Officer MAHIR AFFANEH, STAR No. 19612, as charged herein, is **not guilty** of violating, to-wit:
 - RULE 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.

in that there was insufficient evidence presented by the Superintendent to prove that:

- A. On or about October 7, 2004, while giving a statement to the Internal Affairs Division, he stated that he had never been employed by his brother, Ahmad Affaneh, however he reported on his Personal History Questionnaire Background Investigation that he worked for Ahmad Affaneh's company, Courtesy Remodeling, Inc., from September 1988 through April 1992.
- B. On or about February 15, 2005, while giving a statement to the Internal
 Affairs Division, he denied working secondary employment on October
 28, 2004, when on October 28, 2004, he was observed performing work at

- a gas station at 115th Street and Pulaski Road, including standing on a stepladder removing ceiling tiles.
- C. On or about February 15, 2005, while giving a statement to the Internal Affairs Division, he denied working secondary employment on October 29, 2004, when on October 29, 2004, he was observed performing work at Nelson Food & Liquor located at 3201 West 63rd Place, including loading several sheets of material and/or wood stock into a vehicle, unloading a white bucket from a vehicle, and/or spraying and wiping a sheet of material and/or wood stock.
- D. On or about October 29, 2004, he failed to report to the Medical Services Section to obtain a Return to Duty Notice after being released to return to duty by Mercy Works Medical Center.
- (5) The Respondent, Police Officer MAHIR AFFANEH, STAR No. 19612, as charged herein, is guilty of violating, to-wit:
 - RULE 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.

in that:

- A. On or about October 28, 2004, he engaged in construction activity, including standing on a stepladder removing ceiling tiles, while on the medical roll.
- B. On or about October 29, 2004, he engaged in construction activity, including loading several sheets of material and/or wood stock into a

vehicle, unloading a white bucket from a vehicle, and/or spraying and wiping a sheet of material and/or wood stock, while on the medical roll.

(6) The Respondent, Police Officer **MAHIR AFFANEH**, **STAR No. 19612**, as charged herein, is **not guilty** of violating, to-wit:

RULE 14: Making a false report, written or oral. in that there was insufficient evidence presented by the Superintendent to prove that:

- A. On or about October 7, 2004, while giving a statement to the Internal Affairs Division, he stated that he had never been employed by his brother, Ahmad Affaneh, however he reported on his Personal History Questionnaire Background Investigation that he worked for Ahmad Affaneh's company Courtesy Remodeling, Inc., from September 1988 through April 1992.
- B. (7) Respondent, **POLICE OFFICER MAHIR AFFANEH**, **STAR No. 19612**, as charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to-wit:

RULE 24: Failure to follow medical roll procedures. in that:

- A. On or about October 28, 2004, he engaged in construction activity, including standing on a stepladder removing ceiling tiles, while on the medical roll.
- B. On or about October 29, 2004, he engaged in construction activity, including loading several sheets of material and/or wood stock into a vehicle, unloading a white bucket from a vehicle, and/or spraying and wiping a sheet of material and/or wood stock, while on the medical roll.
- (8) The Respondent, Police Officer MAHIR AFFANEH, STAR No. 19612, as charged herein, is <u>not guilty</u> of violating, to-wit:

RULE 24: Failure to follow medical roll procedures.

in that there was insufficient evidence presented by the Superintendent to prove that:

On or about October 29, 2004, he failed to report to the Medical Services Section to obtain a Return to Duty Notice after being released to return to duty by Mercy Works Medical Center.

BY REASON OF THE FINDINGS OF FACT herein, cause exists for the suspension of the Respondent, Police Officer MAHIR AFFANEH, STAR No. 19612, from his position as a police officer with the Department of Police, and from the services of the City of Chicago, for a period from May 1, 2007, to and including January 31, 2008.


