FINDINGS

On May 24, 2007, the Superintendent of Police filed with the Police Board of the City of Chicago charges against Police Officer Rubin Tevenal, Star No. 19137 (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Respondent"), recommending that the Respondent be discharged from the Chicago Police Department for violating the following Rules of Conduct:

Rule 1: Violation of any law or ordinance;

Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the
 Department's efforts to achieve its policy and
 goals or brings discredit upon the Department;

Rule 8: Disrespect to or maltreatment of any person, while
 on or off duty;

Rule 9: Engaging in any unjustified verbal or physical altercation with any person, while on or off duty;

Rule 10: Inattention to duty;

Rule 15: Intoxication on or off duty; and

Rule 38: Unlawful or unnecessary use or display of a weapon.

The Police Board caused a hearing on these charges against Police Officer Rubin Tevenal to be had before Michael G. Berland, Hearing Officer of the Police Board, on August 23, November 1, and December 12, 2007.

Following the hearing, the members of the Police Board read and reviewed the certified transcription of the hearing and viewed the video-recording of the hearing. Michael G. Berland, Hearing Officer, made an oral report to and conferred with the Police Board before it rendered a decision.

The Police Board of the City of Chicago, as a result of its hearing of the charges, finds and determines that:

- The Respondent was at all times mentioned herein employed as a police officer by the Department of Police of the City of Chicago.
- 2. The charges were filed in writing and a notice, stating the time, date, and place, when and where a hearing of the charges was to be held, together with a copy of the original charges, was served upon the Respondent more than five (5) days prior to the hearing on the charges.
- 3. Throughout the hearing the Respondent appeared in person and was represented by legal counsel.
- 4. The Respondent, Police Officer Rubin Tevenal, Star No. 19137, charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to wit:

Rule 1: Violation of any law or ordinance, in that:

On or about March 16, 2004, at or near 9610 South Avenue L, Chicago, he pointed a firearm at Jesse Chavez, thereby violating Chapter 720 ILCS 5/12-2(a)(1), by committing the act of Aggravated Assault.

- 5. The Respondent, Police Officer Rubin Tevenal, Star No.
- 19137, charged herein, is guilty of violating, to wit:
 - Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department,

in that:

<u>Count I</u>: On or about March 16, 2004, at or near 9610 South Avenue L, Chicago, he pointed a firearm at Jesse Chavez, thereby impeding the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals and/or bringing discredit upon the Department.

Count II: On or about March 16, 2004, at or near 9610 South Avenue L, Chicago, he directed profanity and/or racial epithets toward Jesse Chavez, thereby impeding the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals and/or bringing discredit upon the Department.

Count III: On or about March 16, 2004, and/or March 17, 2004, he was intoxicated while off duty, in that his blood alcohol level was approximately 0.130 g/dL or greater, thereby impeding the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals and/or bringing discredit upon the Department.

Count IV: On or about March 16, 2004, at or near 9609 South Avenue M, Chicago, he failed to adequately secure and/or care for a firearm, namely a 9mm Smith and Wesson, thereby impeding the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals and/or bringing discredit upon the Department.

<u>Count V</u>: On or about March 16, 2004, at or near 9609 South Avenue M, Chicago, he failed to immediately identify himself as a Chicago police officer to on-duty officers responding to a call of a man with a gun, thereby impeding the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals and/or bringing discredit upon the Department.

- 6. The Respondent, Police Officer Rubin Tevenal, Star No.
- 19137, charged herein, is guilty of violating, to wit:

<u>Rule 8</u>: Disrespect to or maltreatment of any person, while on or off duty,

in that:

Count I: On or about March 16, 2004, at or near 9610 South Avenue L, Chicago, he disrespected and/or maltreated Jesse Chavez, in that Police Officer Tevenal pointed a firearm at Mr. Chavez.

<u>Count II</u>: On or about March 16, 2004, at or near 9610 South Avenue L, Chicago, he disrespected and/or maltreated Jesse Chavez, in that Police Officer Tevenal directed profanity and/or racial epithets towards Mr. Chavez.

- 7. The Respondent, Police Officer Rubin Tevenal, Star No.
- 19137, charged herein, is guilty of violating, to wit:

Rule 9: Engaging in any unjustified verbal or physical altercation with any person, while on or off duty,

in that:

On or about March 16, 2004, at or near 9610 South Avenue L, Chicago, he directed profanity and/or racial epithets towards Jesse Chavez, thereby engaging in an unjustified verbal altercation.

- 8. The Respondent, Police Officer Rubin Tevenal, Star No.
- 19137, charged herein, is guilty of violating, to wit:

Rule 10: Inattention to duty,

in that:

On or about March 16, 2004, at or near 9609 South Avenue M, Chicago, he was inattentive to duty, in that he failed to adequately secure and/or care for a firearm, namely a 9mm Smith and Wesson.

9. The Respondent, Police Officer Rubin Tevenal, Star No.

19137, charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to wit:

Rule 15: Intoxication on or off duty,

in that:

On or about March 16, 2004, and/or March 17, 2004, he was intoxicated while off duty, in that his blood alcohol level was approximately 0.130 g/dL or greater.

10. The Respondent, Police Officer Rubin Tevenal, Star No. 19137, charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to wit:

Rule 38: Unlawful or unnecessary use or display of a weapon,

in that:

Count I: On or about March 16, 2004, at or near 9610 South Avenue L, Chicago, he displayed a firearm to Jesse Chavez, thereby engaging in the unlawful or unnecessary use or display of a weapon.

Count II: On or about March 16, 2004, at or near 9610 South Avenue L, Chicago, he pointed a firearm at Jesse Chavez, thereby engaging in the unlawful or unnecessary use or display of a weapon.

By reason of the findings of fact and guilt set forth herein, cause exists for the discharge of the Respondent, Police Officer Rubin Tevenal, Star No. 19137, from his position as a police officer with the Department of Police, and from the services of the City of Chicago.


