FINDINGS AND DECISION

On May 14, 2008, the Superintendent of Police filed with the Police Board of the City of Chicago, charges against Detention Aide Allan Alston, Employee No. 25850 (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Respondent"), recommending that the Respondent be discharged from the Chicago Police Department for violating the following Rules of Conduct:

Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.

<u>Rule 6</u>: Disobedience of an order or directive, whether written or oral.

The Police Board of the City of Chicago caused a hearing on these charges against Detention Aide Allan Alston, Employee No. 25850, to be had before Jacqueline A. Walker, Hearing Officer of the Police Board, on November 18, 2008.

Following the Hearing, the members of the Police Board read and reviewed the record of proceedings and viewed the video-recording of the testimony of witnesses. Hearing Officer Walker made an oral report to and conferred with the Police Board before it rendered a decision.

As a result of the foregoing, the Police Board of the City of Chicago finds and determines that:

(1) The Respondent was, at all times mentioned herein, a detention aide employed

by the Department of Police of the City of Chicago.

- (2) The charges were filed in writing and a Notice, stating the time, date, and place, when and where a hearing on the charges was to be held, together with a copy of the original charges, were served upon the Respondent more than five (5) days prior to the hearing on the charges.
- (3) Throughout the hearing, the Respondent appeared in person and was represented by legal counsel.
- (4) The Respondent, Detention Aide Allan Alston, Employee No. 25850, as charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to-wit:
 - Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department,

in that:

On or about May 30, 2003, he disobeyed a direct order to report to the Department's Random Drug Testing Unit and provide a urine sample as part of his enrollment in the Personal Concerns Program, in that he failed to report to the Department's Random Drug Testing Unit on or about May 30, 2003 in disobedience of a direct order.

- (5) Respondent, Detention Aide Allan Alston, Employee No. 25850, as charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to-wit:
- Rule 6: Disobedience of an order or directive, whether written or oral in that:

On or about May 30, 2003, he failed to report to the Department's Random Drug Testing Unit and provide a urine specimen after being ordered to report to the Department's Random Drug Testing Unit and provide a urine specimen.

BY REASON of the findings of fact and of guilt herein, cause exists for the discharge of Respondent, Detention Aide Allan Alston, Employee No. 25850, from his position as a detention aide, and from the services of the City of Chicago.




