FINDINGS

On February 20, 2009, the Superintendent of Police filed with the Police Board of the City of Chicago charges against Police Officer Bruce Askew, Star No. 9015 (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Respondent"), recommending that the Respondent be discharged from the Chicago Police Department for violating the following Rules of Conduct:

Rule 1: Violation of any law or ordinance.

Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.

Rule 9: Engaging in any unjustified verbal or physical altercation with any person, while on or off duty.

Rule 14: Making a false report, written or oral.

The Police Board caused a hearing on these charges against Police Officer Bruce Askew to be had before Michael G. Berland, Hearing Officer of the Police Board, on July 23 and September 23, 2009.

Following the hearing, the members of the Police Board read and reviewed the record of proceedings and viewed the video-

recording of the testimony of the witnesses. Michael G.

Berland, Hearing Officer, made an oral report to and conferred
with the Police Board before it rendered a decision.

The Police Board of the City of Chicago, as a result of its hearing of the charges, finds and determines that:

- The Respondent was at all times mentioned herein employed as a police officer by the Department of Police of the City of Chicago.
- 2. The charges were filed in writing and a Notice, stating the time, date, and place, when and where a hearing of the charges was to be held, together with a copy of the original charges, were served upon the Respondent more than five (5) days prior to the hearing on the charges.
- 3. The Respondent appeared throughout the hearing and was represented by legal counsel.
- 4. The Superintendent's motion to withdraw the charge that the Respondent violated Rule 14 is granted.
- 5. The Respondent, Police Officer Bruce Askew, Star No. 9015, charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to wit:

Rule 1: Violation of any law or ordinance, in that:

On or about April 15, 2007, at a currency exchange located at or about 6858 South Ashland Avenue, Chicago, while off duty, he intentionally and/or knowingly without legal justification made physical contact of an insulting or provoking nature with Jimmy/James Brown, in that the Respondent pushed Jimmy/James Brown on the neck and/or chest and/or shoulder area, in violation of Chapter 720 ILCS 5/12-3(a)(2).

6. The Respondent, Police Officer Bruce Askew, Star No. 9015, charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to wit:

Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department,

in that:

Count I: On or about April 15, 2007, at the currency exchange located at or about 6858 South Ashland Avenue, Chicago, while off duty, he pushed on the neck and/or chest and/or shoulder area a civilian, Jimmy/James Brown, who knew the Respondent to be a police officer, and/or pushed newspapers that were on the window ledge onto the floor, thereby impeding the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals and/or bringing discredit upon the Department.

7. The Respondent, Police Officer Bruce Askew, Star No. 9015, charged herein, is **not guilty** of violating, to wit:

Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department,

in that:

Count II: The Superintendent did not prove by a preponderance of the evidence that on or about April 16, 2007, at the currency exchange located at or about 6858 South Ashland Avenue, Chicago, while on duty, the Respondent arrested a civilian, Jimmy/James Brown, in retaliation for Jimmy/James Brown filing a complaint against the Respondent with the Office of Professional Standards (now the Independent Police Review Authority), thereby impeding the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals and/or bringing discredit upon the Department.

8. The Respondent, Police Officer Bruce Askew, Star No. 9015, charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to wit:

Rule 9: Engaging in any unjustified verbal or physical altercation with any person, while on or off duty,

in that:

On or about April 15, 2007, at the currency exchange located at or about 6858 South Ashland Avenue, Chicago, while off duty, he pushed on the neck and/or chest and/or shoulder area a civilian, Jimmy/James Brown, thereby engaging in an unjustified physical altercation with any person while off duty.

By reason of the findings of fact and guilt set forth herein, cause exists for the suspension of the Respondent, Police Officer Bruce Askew, Star No. 9015, from his position as a police officer with the Department of Police, and from the services of the City of Chicago, for a period of one (1) year, from March 1, 2009, to and including February 28, 2010.


