### **FINDINGS**

On March 6, 2009, the Superintendent of Police filed with the Police Board of the City of Chicago charges against Police Officer Dante Walker, Star No. 18396 (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Respondent"), recommending that the Respondent be discharged from the Chicago Police Department for violating the following Rules of Conduct:

Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.

Rule 4: Any conduct or action taken to use the official position for personal gain or influence.

Rule 14: Making a false report, written or oral.

Rule 47: Associating or fraternizing with any person known to have been convicted of any felony or misdemeanor, either State or Federal, excluding traffic and municipal ordinance violations.

The Police Board caused a hearing on these charges against Police Officer Dante Walker to be had before Thomas E. Johnson, Hearing Officer of the Police Board, on August 13, September 11, October 1, and October 21, 2009.

Following the hearing, the members of the Police Board read and reviewed the record of proceedings and viewed the video-recording of the testimony of the witnesses. Hearing Officer Johnson made an oral report to and conferred with the Police Board before it rendered a decision.

The Police Board of the City of Chicago, as a result of its hearing of the charges, finds and determines that:

1. The Respondent was at all times mentioned herein employed as a police officer by the Department of Police of the City of Chicago.

- 2. The charges were filed in writing and a Notice, stating the time, date, and place, when and where a hearing of the charges was to be held, together with a copy of the original charges, were served upon the Respondent more than five (5) days prior to the hearing on the charges.
- 3. The Respondent appeared in person throughout the hearing and was represented by legal counsel.
- 4. The Respondent, Police Officer Dante Walker, Star No. 18396, charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to wit:

Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department,

in that:

Count I: On or about February 23, 2006, he used his official position for personal gain by using his City of Chicago Police Department User Identification and Password to access the Arrestee History Report and/or Criminal Report of Breanna Smith, also known as Nadia Smith, thereby bringing discredit upon the Department.

Count II: On or about July 6, 2007, at the Office of Professional Standards (now known as the Independent Police Review Authority), located at or near 10 West 35<sup>th</sup> Street, Suite 1200, Chicago, he made false statements to Investigator Alice Chico when he denied knowing that Nadia Smith was a convicted felon, thereby bringing discredit upon the Department.

Count III: On or about July 6, 2007, at the Office of Professional Standards (now known as the Independent Police Review Authority), located at or near 10 West 35<sup>th</sup> Street, Suite 1200, Chicago, he made false statements to Investigator Alice Chico when he denied obtaining Nadia Smith's Criminal History and/or Arrestee History, thereby bringing discredit upon the Department.

<u>Count IV</u>: From in or about November of 2004 through in or about May of 2007, or for some period of time therein, he associated with Nadia Smith, an individual he knew to be convicted of one or more felonies, thereby bringing discredit upon the Department.

5. The Respondent, Police Officer Dante Walker, Star No. 18396, charged herein, is guilty of violating, to wit:

Rule 4: Any conduct or action taken to use the official position for personal gain or influence,

in that:

On or about February 23, 2006, he used his official position for personal gain by using his City of Chicago Police Department User Identification and Password to access the

Arrestee History Report and/or Criminal Report of Breanna Smith, also known as Nadia Smith.

6. The Respondent, Police Officer Dante Walker, Star No. 18396, charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to wit:

Rule 14:

Making a false report, written or oral,

in that:

<u>Count I</u>: On or about July 6, 2007, at the Office of Professional Standards (now known as the Independent Police Review Authority), located at or near 10 West 35<sup>th</sup> Street, Suite 1200, Chicago, he made false statements to Investigator Alice Chico when he denied knowing that Nadia Smith was a convicted felon.

Count III: On or about July 6, 2007, at the Office of Professional Standards (now known as the Independent Police Review Authority), located at or near 10 West 35<sup>th</sup> Street, Suite 1200, Chicago, he made false statements to Investigator Alice Chico when he denied obtaining Nadia Smith's Criminal History and/or Arrestee History.

7. The Respondent, Police Officer Dante Walker, Star No. 18396, charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to wit:

Rule 47:

Associating or fraternizing with any person known to have been convicted of any felony or misdemeanor, either State or Federal, excluding traffic and municipal ordinance violations,

in that:

From in or about November of 2004 through in or about May of 2007, or for some period of time therein, he associated with Nadia Smith, an individual he knew to be convicted of one or more felonies.

By reason of the findings of fact and guilt set forth herein, cause exists for the discharge of the Respondent, Police Officer Dante Walker, Star No. 18396, from his position as a police officer with the Department of Police, and from the services of the City of Chicago.


