CHARGES

Police Officer Adis Klinecivic, Star No. 18392, is charged with violating the following rules contained in Article V of the Rules and Regulations of the Chicago Police Department, which were in full force and effect on the date of the alleged violations:

- Rule 1: Violation of any law or ordinance.
- Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.
- Rule 6: Disobedience of an order or directive, whether written or oral.

SPECIFICATIONS

1. Police Officer Adis Klinecivic, Star Number 18392, is charged with violating Rule 1, "Violation of any law or ordinance," in the following instance:

On or about October 22, 2012, Police Officer Adis Klinecivic rendered a urine specimen that contained one or more of the following: nandrolone metabolites, fluoxymesterone metabolites, boldenone metabolites, trenbolone metabolites, drostanolone metabolites, and/or stanozolol metabolites; thus he possessed one or more anabolic steroids on or before October 22, 2012, in violation of Chapter 720 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, Section 570/402(d).

2. Police Officer Adis Klinecivic, Star Number 18392, is charged with violating Rule 2, "Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department," in one or more of the following instances:

Count I: On or about October 22, 2012, Police Officer Adis Klinecivic rendered a urine specimen that contained one or more of the following: nandrolone metabolites, fluoxymesterone metabolites, boldenone metabolites, trenbolone metabolites, drostanolone metabolites, and/or stanozolol metabolites, thereby impeding the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals and/or bringing discredit upon the Department.

Count II: In or around 2012, Police Officer Adis Klinecivic ingested and/or used or otherwise absorbed into his body supplements and/or veterinary pharmaceuticals containing metabolic precursors to anabolic steroids and/or anabolic steroids, and/or he ingested and/or used or otherwise absorbed into his body anabolic steroids, thereby impeding the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals and/or bringing discredit upon the Department.

3. Police Officer Adis Klincevic, Star Number 18392, is charged with violating Rule 6, "Disobedience of an order or directive, whether written or oral," in one or more of following instances:

Count I: On or about October 22, 2012, Police Officer Adis Klincevic rendered a urine specimen that contained one or more of the following: nandrolone metabolites, fluoxymesterone metabolites, boldenone metabolites, trenbolone metabolites, drostanolone metabolites, and/or stanozolol metabolites, thereby violating Employee Resource E01-09, Section II(B).

Count II: In or around 2012, Police Officer Adis Klincevic ingested and/or used or otherwise absorbed into his body supplements and/or veterinary pharmaceuticals containing metabolic precursors to anabolic steroids and/or anabolic steroids, and/or he ingested and/or used or otherwise absorbed into his body anabolic steroids, thereby violating Employee Resource E01-09, Section II(B).

Based on the foregoing charges and specifications, the Superintendent recommends that Police Officer Adis Klincevic, Star Number 18392, be discharged from the Chicago Police Department.
