### CHARGES

Officer Kevin D. Wyman, Star Number 17764, is charged with violating the following rule contained in Article V of the Rules and Regulations of the Chicago Police Department, which were in full force and effect on the date of the alleged violations:

Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.

### SPECIFICATIONS


1. Officer Kevin D. Wyman, Star Number 17764, is charged with violating Rule 2, "Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department," in the following instance:

On or about January 2, 2010, Police Officer Kevin D. Wyman hindered the preliminary investigation of a motor vehicle accident he was involved in (specifically, RD #HS101855) by fleeing a Chicago Fire Department ambulance in the vicinity of MacNeal Hospital in Berwyn, Illinois, at approximately 2:00pm, thus preventing on-duty Department members from investigating whether Officer Wyman was intoxicated, thereby impeding the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or bringing discredit upon the Department.

Based on the foregoing charges and specifications, the Superintendent recommends that Police Officer Kevin D. Wyman, Star Number 17764, be suspended from the Chicago Police Department for a period of 45 days.
