## CHARGES

Police Officer Robert Gallegos, Star Number 19717, is charged with violating the following rules contained in Article V of the Rules and Regulations of the Chicago Police Department, which were in full force and effect on the date of the alleged violations:

Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.

## SPECIFICATIONS


1. Police Officer Robert Gallegos, Star Number 19717, is charged with violating Rule 2, "Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department," in one or more of the following instances:

Count I: On or about January 4, 2011, the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board decertified your previous certification and ability to practice as a law enforcement officer in Illinois under 50 ILCS 705/6.1, as a result of your being found guilty on or about March 20, 2009, in the Circuit Court of Cook County, Criminal Division, in case 08 CR 0899101, of one or more counts under 720 ILCS 5/12-4, (re-numbered as 720 ILCS 5/12-3.05 on or about July 1, 2011), "Aggravated Battery," and/or one or more counts under 720 ILCS 5/33-3, "Official Misconduct," a conviction deemed to be a decertification under the Illinois Police Training Act, 50 ILCS 705/1, *et seq.*, thereby impeding the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals and/or bringing discredit upon the Department.

Based on the foregoing charges and specifications, the Superintendent recommends that Police Officer Robert Gallegos, Star Number 19717, be discharged from the Chicago Police Department.
