ORDER

On October 25, 2016, the Superintendent of Police filed with the Police Board of the City of Chicago Charges against Police Officer Carl Belaschky, Star No. 11814 (hereinafter referred to as "Respondent"), recommending that the Respondent be discharged from the Chicago Police Department for violating several Rules of Conduct (a copy of the Charges is attached as Exhibit A).
