CHARGES AGAINST POLICE OFFICER JASON VAN DYKE

Police Officer Jason Van Dyke, Star Number 9465, is charged with violating the following rules contained in Article V of the Rules and Regulations of the Chicago Police Department (the "Department"), which were in full force and effect on the date of the alleged violations:

Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.

Rule 3: Any failure to promote the Department's efforts to implement its policy or accomplish its goals.

SPECIFICATIONS

- 1. On or about January 22, 2019, the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board decertified Officer Jason Van Dyke's previous certification and ability to practice as a law enforcement officer in Illinois under 50 ILCS 705/6.1, as a result of a criminal conviction on October 5, 2018, in the Circuit Court of Cook County, for one count of Second Degree Murder (720 ILCS 5/9-2) and sixteen (16) counts of Aggravated Battery (720 ILCS 5/12-3.05-E-1), deemed to be a decertification under the Illinois Police Training Act 50 ILCS 705/1, et seq. Officer Van Dyke thereby:
 - a. Engaged in any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department in violation of Rule 2.
 - b. Engaged in any action which fails to promote the Department's efforts to implement its policy or accomplish its goals in violation of Rule 3.

Based on the foregoing charges and specifications, the Superintendent recommends that Police Officer Jason Van Dyke, Star Number 9465, be discharged from the Chicago Police Department.
