FINDINGS & DECISION

On August 21, 1998, the Superintendent of Police filed charges with the Police

Board of the City of Chicago, seeking the termination of Police Officer ERNEST

HUTCHINSON, Star # 7118, hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Respondent" for

violating the following rules:

<u>**Rule 1**</u>: "Violation of any law or ordinance."

- **<u>Rule 2</u>**: "Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department."
- **<u>Rule 4:</u>** "Any conduct or action taken to use the official position for personal gain or influence."
- **<u>Rule 8</u>**: "Disrespect to or maltreatment of any person, while on or off duty."

The Police Board of the City of Chicago caused a hearing on these charges against Police Officer ERNEST HUTCHINSON to be had before JACQUELINE A.

Following the hearing, the members of the Police Board read and reviewed the certified transcription of the proceedings of the hearing. JACQUELINE A. WALKER,

WALKER, Hearing Officer of the Police Board of the City of Chicago on June 28, 2005.

Hearing Officer, made a report and conferred with the Police Board before it rendered a decision.

As a result of the foregoing, the Police Board of the City of Chicago finds and determines that:

1. The Respondent was, at all times mentioned herein, a Police Officer employed by the Department of Police of the City of Chicago;

2. The charges were filed, in writing, and a Notice, stating the time, date and place, when and where a hearing of the charges was to be held, together with a copy of the original charges, were served upon the Respondent more than five (5) days prior to the hearing on the charges;

3. Throughout the hearing, the Respondent did not appear in person and was not represented by counsel.

4. The Respondent, Police Officer **ERNEST HUTCHINSON**, Star # 7118, as charged herein, is **guilty** of violating, to wit:

<u>Rule 1</u>: "Violation of any law or ordinance", in the following instances:

A) On or about June 23, 1998, he committed the offense of home invasion, in that he, not acting in the line of duty, without authority knowingly entered the dwelling of Cecilio Lugo at or near 1200 West Huron Street, Chicago, Illinois, when he knew or had reason to know that one or more persons were present, and while armed with a weapon used force or the imminent threat of force upon Cecilio Lugo, and/or Wanda Lugo and/or Sonia Guzman, in violation of 720 ILCS 5/12-11.





B) On or about June 23, 1998, at or near 1200 West Huron Street,
 Chicago, Illinois, he committed the offense of armed robbery, in that
 he, while armed with a dangerous weapon, took \$8,000.00 in cash
 from Cecilio Lugo by the use of force or by threatening the imminent
 use of force, in violation of 720 ILCS 5/18-2.

- C) On or about June 23, 1998, at or near 1200 West Huron Street,
 Chicago, Illinois, Officer Carriger committed the offense of official misconduct, in that he, while on duty as a Chicago Police Officer,
 knowingly performed an act which he knew was forbidden by law to perform, in violation of 720 ILCS 5/33-3(b).
 - On or about June 23, 1998, at or near 1200 West Huron Street, Chicago, Illinois, he committed the offense of official misconduct, in that he, while on duty as a Chicago Police Officer, with intent to obtain a personal advantage for himself or another, performed an act in excess of his lawful authority, i.e., unlawfully requested money from Cecilio Lugo, in violation of 720 ILCS 5/33-3(c).

On or about June 23, 1998, at or near 1200 West Huron Street, Chicago, Illinois, he committed the offense of aggravated unlawful restraint, in that he, while using a deadly weapon, knowingly without legal authority detained Wanda Lugo, in violation of 720 ILCS 5/10-3.1.

On or about June 23, 1998, at or near 1200 West Huron Street, Chicago, Illinois, he committed the offense of aggravated unlawful

restraint, in that he, while using a deadly weapon, knowingly without legal authority detained Sonia Guzman, in violation of 720 ILCS 5/10-3.1.

5. The Respondent, Police Officer ERNEST HUTCHINSON, Star # 7118, is charged herein, is guilty of violating, to wit:

- **<u>Rule 2</u>**: "Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department", in the following instances:
 - A) On or about June 23, 1998, at or near 1200 West Huron Street, Chicago,
 Illinois, he, while on duty, unlawfully took \$ 8,000.00 in cash from
 Cecilio Lugo, thereby impeding the Department's efforts to achieve its
 policy and goals and/or bringing discredit upon the Department.
 - B) On or about June 23, 1998, at or near 1200 West Huron Street, Chicago,
 Illinois, he, without legal authority, handcuffed and forcibly detained
 Wando Lugo, thereby impeding the Department's efforts to achieve its
 policy and goals and/or bringing discredit upon the Department.
 - C) On or about June 23, 1998, at or near 1200 West Huron Street, Chicago,
 Illinois, he, without legal authority, forcibly detained Sonia Guzman,
 thereby impeding the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals
 and/or bringing discredit upon the Department.
 - 6. The Respondent, Police Officer ERNEST HUTCHINSON, Star # 7118, as charged herein, is guilty of violating, to wit:

<u>Rule 4:</u> "Any conduct or action taken to use the official position for personal gain or influence", in that:

On or about June 23, 1998, at or near 1200 West Huron, Chicago, Illinois, he, while on duty, used his official position as a Chicago Police Officer to gain entry to the apartment of Cecilio Lugo and to unlawfully take money from Cecilio Lugo.

- The Respondent, Police Officer ERNEST HUTCHINSON, Star # 7118, as charged herein, is guilty of violating, to wit:
- **<u>Rule 8:</u>** "Disrespect to or maltreatment of any person, while on or off duty", in the following instances:
 - A) On or about June 23, 1998, at or near 1200 West Huron Street,
 Chicago, Illinois, he, while on duty and without legal authority
 handcuffed and forcibly detained Wanda Lugo, thereby being
 disrespectful to and/or maltreating her.
 - B) On or about June 23, 1998, at or near 1200 West Huron Street, Chicago, Illinois, he, while on duty, told Wanda Lugo to "shut the fuck up before I gag you", thereby being disrespectful to and/or maltreating her.
- C) On or about June 23, 1998, at or near 1200 West Huron Street,
 Chicago, Illinois, he shoved Sonia Guzman and called her a "bitch" and spat on her, thereby being disrespectful to and/or maltreating her.
 BY REASON of the findings of fact and guilt herein, cause exists for the

discharge of Respondent, Police Officer ERNEST HUTCHINSON, Star # 7118, from

the Department of Police and from the services of the City of Chicago.
