CHARGES

Debra Watson, Employee No. 526217, is charged with violating the following rules contained in Article V of the Rules and Regulations of the Chicago Police Department, which were in full force and effect on the date of the alleged violations:

Rule 1: Violation of any law or ordinance;

Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve

its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department;

Rule 6: Disobedience of an order or directive, whether written or oral;

Rule 14: Making a false report, written or oral;

Rule 25: Failure to actually reside within the corporate boundaries of the City of

Chicago;

Rule 26: Failure to provide the Department with a current address and telephone

number.

SPECIFICATIONS

1. Debra Watson, Employee No. 526217, is charged with violating Rule 1, "Violation of any law or ordinance," in the following instance:

Count I: From July 14, 1998, to the present, or for some period of time therein, she

failed to reside within the corporate boundaries of the City of Chicago, in violation of Title 2, Chapter 27, Section 340 of the Municipal Code of

Chicago.

2. Debra Watson, Employee No. 526217, is charged with violating Rule 2, "Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department," in one or more of the following instances:

Count I: From July 14, 1998 to the present, or for some period of time therein, she

failed to reside within the corporate boundaries of the City of Chicago, thereby impeding the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals

and/or bringing discredit upon the Department.

Count II: On or about January 21, 1999, she falsely stated that she resided within the

corporate boundaries of the City of Chicago, when in fact she did not, thereby impeding the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals

and/or bringing discredit to the Department.

3. Debra Watson, Employee No. 526217, is charged with violating Rule 6,

"Disobedience of an order or directive, whether written or oral," in the following instance:

Count I:

From July 14, 1998, to the present, or for some period of time therein, she failed to submit "Personnel Change Notice" and/or change of address forms to the Chicago Police Department with regard to her change of address and /or telephone number when she ceased residing at 737 North Mayfield, Chicago, Illinois, thereby disobeying General order 94-5.

4. Debra Watson, Employee No. 526217, is charged with violating Rule 14, "Making a false report, written or oral," in the following instance:

Count I:

On or about January 21, 1999, she stated that she resided within the corporate boundaries of the City of Chicago, when in fact she did not, thereby giving a false report.

5. Debra Watson, Employee No. 526217, is charged with violating Rule 25, "Failure to actually reside within the corporate boundaries of the City of Chicago," in the following instance:

Count I:

From July 14, 1998, to the present, or for some period of time therein, she failed to reside within the corporate boundaries of the City of Chicago.

6. Debra Watson, Employee No. 526217, is charged with violating Rule 26, "Failure to provide the Department with a current address and telephone number," in the following instance:

Count I:

From July 14, 1998, to the present, or for some period of time therein, she failed to notify the Department of her address when she ceased residing within the corporate boundaries of the City of Chicago, thereby failing to provide the Department with a current address and phone number.

Based on the foregoing charges and specifications, the Superintendent recommends that Debra Watson, Employee No. 526217, be discharged from the Chicago Police Department.
