### FINDINGS & DECISION

On July 22, 1999, the Superintendent of Police filed charges with the Police Board of the City of Chicago against Crossing Guard Sherrithe Pearson, Employee #538236, (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Respondent") seeking her discharge for violating the following Rules:

Rule 1: Violation of any law or ordinance

Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and/or goals and/or brings discredit upon the Department.

The Police Board of the City of Chicago caused a hearing on these charges against Investigator 11 Sherrithe Pearson to be had before Michael G. Berland, Hearing Officer of the Police Board of the City of Chicago on August 18, 1999.

Following the hearing, the members of the Police Board read and reviewed the certified transcription of the proceedings of the hearing. Michael G. Berland, Hearing Officer, made an oral report and conferred with the Police Board before it rendered a decision.

The Police Board of the City of Chicago, as a result of its investigation of the charges, finds and determines that:

- 1. The Respondent was at all times a Crossing Guard employed by the Department of Police of the City of Chicago.
- 2. The charges were filed in writing and a Notice, stating the time, date and place, when and where a hearing of the charges was to be held, together with a copy of the original charges, was served upon the Respondent more than five (5) days prior to the hearing on the charges.
- 3. The hearing was conducted before Michael G. Berland, Hearing Officer of the Police Board of the City of Chicago, on August 18, 1999.
- 4. Throughout the hearing the Respondent did appear in person on August 18, 1999 and represented herself.
- 5. Respondent Crossing Guard Sherrithe Pearson, Employee #538236, charged herein, contrary to the Rules and Regulations, is guilty of violating, to wit:
- Rule 1: Violation of any law or ordinance.
- A. On or around March 25, 1999, at Marshall Fields, 835

  North Michigan Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, Crossing Guard

  Sherrithe Pearson committed the offense of retail theft in that she took possession of merchandise displayed for sale in Marshall Fields, a retail mercantile establishment, with the intention of retaining such merchandise or the intention of depriving the merchant permanently of the benefit of such merchandise without paying the full retail value of such merchandise, thereby violating Chapter 720 ILCS 5/16-3(a).
  - 6. Respondent Crossing Guard Sherrithe Pearson, Employee

#528236, charged herein, contrary to the Rules and Regulations, is guilty of violating, to wit:

Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and/or goals and/or brings discredit upon the Department.

A. On or around March 25, 1999, at Marshall Fields, 835

North Michigan Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, Crossing Guard

Sherrithe Pearson, while wearing a Chicago Police Department

overcoat and safety vest, committed the offense of retail theft

for which she was subsequently arrested and charged, thereby

impeding the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals

and/or bringing discredit upon the Department.

By reason of the fact that Crossing Guard Sherrithe Pearson is guilty of violating Rules 1 and 2, cause exists for the discharge and termination of Respondent Crossing Guard Sherrithe Pearson from her position as a Crossing Guard from the Department of Police and from the services of the City of Chicago.


